### KODIAK COMMERCIAL SALMON FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT #13 For Emergency Order #4-FS-K-13-25

There will be a <u>57-hour</u> commercial salmon fishing period from **noon Saturday**, July 12 to 9:00 p.m. Monday, July 14 in the Duck Bay Section of the Afognak District.

There will be a <u>105-hour</u> commercial salmon fishing period from **noon Sunday**, July 13 to 9:00 p.m. Thursday, July 17 in the following areas:

- The Northwest Kodiak District;
- The Northeast Kodiak District;
- The Eastside Kodiak District;
- The **Afognak District** (except the Duck Bay Section is open for 57 hours beginning noon Saturday, July 12 and the Izhut Bay, Inner Kitoi Bay, and Outer Kitoi Bay Sections remain closed); and
- The Outer Ayakulik Section of the Southwest Kodiak District.

There will be a <u>57-hour</u> commercial salmon fishing period in the Mainland District from noon Sunday, July 13 to 9:00 p.m. Tuesday, July 15.

#### **Closed Water Adjustments:**

Closed waters will be **reduced** from **noon Sunday**, July 13 to 9:00 p.m. Thursday, July 17 at Saltery Creek (stream # 259-415) to the stream terminus.

## As Previously Announced:

## **Concerning the North Shelikof Strait Fishery:**

Short notice, inperiod closures may occur for seine fisheries in the Seaward Zones of the North Shelikof Strait area **(including the Cape Igvak Section)**, as designated in the North Shelikof Strait Sockeye Salmon Management Plan (5 AAC 18.363). Closure announcements may occur at 8:30 a.m., 10:00 a.m., noon, 2:00 p.m., 5:00 p.m., or 8:00 p.m. on VHF channel 6.

<u>Cost recovery fisheries</u> have begun in the Spiridon Bay Special Harvest Area (SHA) and the Spiridon Bay SHA will remain <u>closed</u> to common property fishing. Fishery opportunities in the Spiridon Bay SHA will be dependent on the ability to meet KRAA cost recovery needs. Cost recovery information can be obtained by calling 486-6559.

Fishermen are reminded that in the Kodiak Area (including the Mainland District) until further notice, Chinook (king) salmon 28 inches or greater in length may not be retained by purse seine gear in the commercial fishery and must be returned to the water unharmed.

Other closed waters are as shown on the Kodiak Area Salmon Statistical Chart and detailed in the Commercial Salmon Fishing Regulations (5AAC 18.350).
