Lower Cook Inlet Salmon Fishery Advisory Announcement #15

SOUTHERN DISTRICT: Purse seine: In the Southern District, the following areas will open on Tuesday, July 22 for a 16-hour fishing period from 6:00 AM to 10:00 PM in addition to the ongoing schedule of Monday, Wednesday, and Friday 16-hour commercial fishing periods beginning at 6:00 AM on those days,

- the Halibut Cove Subdistrict,
- the Tutka Bay Subdistrict, excluding the Tutka Bay Hatchery special harvest area (SHA) southeast of a line between a point at 59° 28.22' N. Lat., 151° 27.85' W. Long., and another point at 59° 28.76' N. Lat., 151° 26.75' W. Long., and
- the Neptune Bay and China Poot Bay sections, excluding the Hazel Lake and China Poot SHAs.

Commercial common property seine harvest from the Southern District on Friday, July 18 was approximately 70,000 sockeye salmon. Total harvest from this fishery is approximately 110,000 sockeye salmon with six CFEC permit holders reporting deliveries.

The next scheduled commercial salmon fisheries announcement is anticipated to be on Friday, July 25.
