Port Moller Commercial Salmon Fishery Advisory Announcement #14 **Emergency Order #4-FS-M-PM-14-25**

The Bear River, Three Hills, and Ilnik Sections will remain open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 p.m. Saturday, July 26, until 6:00 p.m. Monday, July 28.

The closed waters at Bear River remain 1,000 yards from the stream terminus at the ocean shoreline until further notice. All other closed waters are as described in the regulation book or as adjusted by emergency order.

The Outer Port Heiden Section will open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 a.m. Monday, July 28, until 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 30.

Statistical charts and harvest strategies are available at the Sand Point, Cold Bay, and Port Moller Fish and Game offices.
