The Bear River, Three Hills, and Ilnik Sections will remain open to commercial salmon fishing from 6:00 p.m. Monday, July 28, until 6:00 p.m. Wednesday, July 30.

The closed waters at Bear River remain 1,000 yards from the stream terminus at the ocean shoreline until further notice. All other closed waters are as described in the regulation book or as adjusted by emergency order.
