KODIAK COMMERCIAL HERRING SAC ROE FISHERY ADVISORY ANNOUNCEMENT #04 For Emergency Order #4-FH-K-04-25

Beginning at **9:00 a.m. Friday, October 10**, **tenders** will be allowed in the Kodiak herring sac roe fishery B season. Fishermen are reminded that all permit holders, tenders, and processors must register with the Kodiak ADF&G office prior to taking any fish.

As Previously Announced:

The Kodiak herring sac roe fishery B season began at **9:00 a.m. Tuesday, July 1**. All sac roe herring **permit holders** and **processors** participating are **required to register** with the Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G) Kodiak office prior to participating in the B season. The total 2025 Kodiak Area sac roe herring B season Guideline Harvest Level (GHL) is **1,987 tons**.

ADF&G is allowing permit holders to conduct the commercial sac roe herring B season under the following guidelines:

- 1) The Kodiak Area sac roe B season will occur from July 1 to October 25.
- 2) The sac roe B season GHL will be based on 35% of the remaining sac roe A season GHL minus 1,000 tons reserved for the sac roe C season.
- 3) Only certain sections of a district will open for the sac roe B season (see table below).
- 4) Districts and combined sections will open and close by emergency order.
- 5) The sac roe herring B season fishery will only take place within state waters.
- 6) All herring permit holders and buyers participating are required to register with the ADF&G Kodiak office.
- 7) All sac roe herring B season fishermen are required to report their catch with the ADF&G Kodiak office immediately upon landing any commercial herring. Failure to do so will result in adjacent area closures.
- 8) Each district or combined sections will be closed for the remainder of the sac roe herring B season when the GHL is reached.

FISHING PERIODS:

PURSE SEINE: Fishing periods for purse seine gear will be from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. each day.

GILLNET: Gillnet fishing periods will be from noon on even-numbered days to noon on odd-numbered days starting July 2.
