SOUTHEAST ALASKA COMMERCIAL GEODUCK FISHERY ANNOUNCEMENT

The following area will be open for the commercial harvest of geoduck for live sale with a 500-pound harvest limit from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Wednesday, November 12, and from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Thursday, November 13, 2025:

North Kirk Point to Bullhead Cove (Subdistrict 101-23-003): will be open for a guideline harvest level of 20,700 pounds of geoduck.

For a description of the above area, please refer to the Southeast Alaska commercial geoduck fishery announcement dated August 29, 2025, announcing the open area and their guideline harvest levels. For this opening, no more than four CFEC geoduck permit holders may be on board, fish, or make landings from a registered vessel and no more than two CFEC geoduck permit holders may be actively in the water conducting fishing operations at the same time. All geoducks harvested must be clearly labeled with the date of harvest, the harvester's name, and the location of harvest. Companies buying geoduck must contact the Fish and Game, Ketchikan office with a harvest report before 12:00 noon on Friday, November 14, 2025.

State offices will be closed, Tuesday, November 11, for Veterans Day.
