Lower Cook Inlet Salmon Fishery Advisory Announcement #7

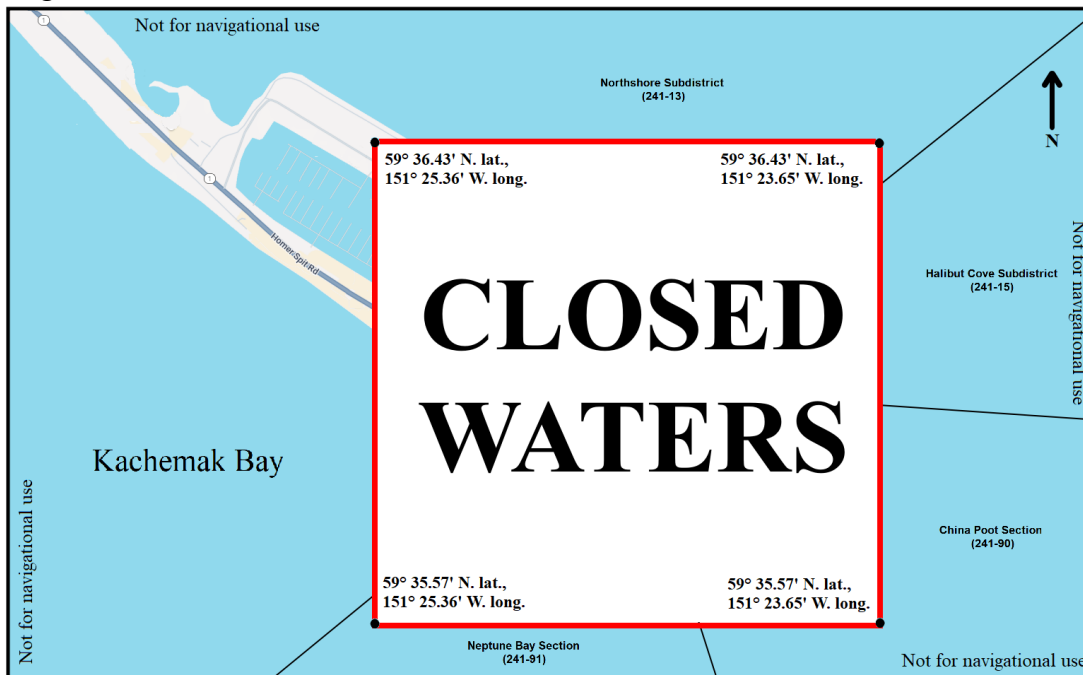


Figure 1.- Closed waters in the area of Coal Point at the end of the Homer Spit.

SOUTHERN DISTRICT: Purse seine: Effective at 10:00 PM on Wednesday, July 1, waters in the vicinity of Coal Point at the end of the Homer Spit, within a one mile square area, as defined by the following vertices: 59° 36.43' N. lat., 151° 25.36' W. long., 59° 36.43' N. lat., 151° 23.65' W. long., 59° 35.57' N. lat., 151° 23.65' W. long., and 59° 35.57' N. lat., 151° 25.36' W. longitude are closed to commercial salmon harvest until further notice. See Figure 1 below.

The following areas remain open on a schedule of Monday, Wednesday, and Friday 16-hour commercial fishing periods beginning at 6:00 AM on those days, the Halibut Cove Subdistrict, the Tutka Bay Subdistrict, excluding the Tutka Bay Hatchery special harvest area (SHA), and the Neptune Bay and China Poot Bay sections, excluding the Hazel Lake and China Poot SHAs. The Northshore Subdistrict and all other areas of the Southern District remain closed to commercial purse seine salmon harvest.

The next scheduled commercial salmon fisheries announcement is anticipated to be on Friday, July 3.
