Bristol Bay Eastside Salmon Update # 8

This is the Alaska Department of Fish and Game in King Salmon with an update for Naknek-Kvichak District fishermen. The time is 9:00 a.m. and the date is Saturday, June 24, 2017.

The cumulative catch in the Naknek-Kvichak District is 36,000. The Naknek River escapement on June 23 was 1,250 sockeye for a cumulative of 13,700; the Kvichak River cumulative escapement is 800 sockeye. The Kvichak River test fish project has caught one sockeye in the past four tides. District test fishing will begin today.

Fishermen in the Naknek-Kvichak District should stand-by at 9:00 a.m. Sunday, June 25.
