EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the state of Alaska resident and nonresident moose hunt for the Gustavus Forelands, RM049 at 11:59pm on Wednesday, October 1, 2025.

REGULATORY TEXT:

Therefore, the provisions of 5 AAC 85.045, HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR MOOSE, are superseded by this emergency order(R1-11-25), and the following provisions are effective for hunting moose in Unit 1(C):

The remainder of Unit 1(C) moose seasons, other than those previously closed by emergency order, are not affected by this emergency order.

(Douglas)- Prior to the season ADF&G set a harvest quota for the Gustavus area registration moose hunt, RM049, of 13 bulls for harvest in this hunt.
