EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the state registration permit hunt RM435 for moose in Unit 14C, in the upper Ship Creek drainage. All other moose hunting seasons in Unit 14 are unaffected by this emergency order.

REGULATION:

Therefore, the following regulations in 5AAC 85.045(12), **Hunting Seasons and Bag Limits for Moose**, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective for hunting moose:

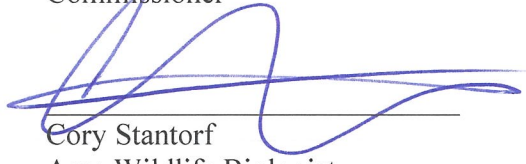

All other moose hunting regulations in Unit 14 remain unchanged and are not affected by this emergency order.

In order to maintain the desired overall population objective of this hunt area, the harvest objective was not to exceed a harvest of 5 bulls. As of November 4th, there were four bulls reported harvested and additional hunters remain in the field; therefore, no further harvest is warranted from this hunt.
