EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the state registration permit hunt RM435 for moose in Unit 14C, in the upper Ship Creek drainage. All other moose hunting seasons in Unit 14 are unaffected by this emergency order.

Therefore, the following regulations in 5AAC 85.045(12), **Hunting Seasons and Bag Limits for Moose**, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective for hunting moose:

Unit 14(C), that portion of the Ship Creek drainage upstream of the Joint Base Elmendorf-Richardson (JBER) Management Area

1 bull by registration permit only

October 25-November 5 (General hunt only)

All other moose hunting regulations in Unit 14 remain unchanged and are not affected by this emergency order.
