EXPLANATION:

This Emergency Order closes the state registration permit hunt RM445 for moose in Unit 14(C). All other moose hunting seasons in Unit 14 are unaffected by this Emergency Order.

REGULATION:

Therefore the following regulations in 5AAC 85.045(12), **Hunting Seasons and Bag Limits for Moose**, are superseded by this Emergency Order, and the following provisions are effective for hunting moose:

Unit 14(C), the Eklutna Lake Management Area	September 1- September 17 (General hunt only)	September 1- September 17
1 bull by registration permit, by bow and arrow only; up to 4 bulls may be taken ...		

All other moose hunting regulations in Unit 14 remain unchanged and are not affected by this emergency order.

JUSTIFICATION:

In 2023, the Eklutna Lake Management Area moose population was estimated at 70 individuals. To maintain appropriate bull:cow ratios and to stay within the overall population objective for Unit 14C, the Department has determined the harvest from the Eklutna Lake Management Area should not exceed four bulls. As of September 16, four bulls have been taken in this hunt and there are still hunters in the field; therefore, no further harvest is warranted from this population.
