JUSTIFICATION:

The 2023 moose population point estimate for Unit 6B, east of the Copper River Delta and including the Martin River Valley, was 260 moose (90% CI 211-309). The department set a maximum allowable harvest of 25 bulls for the 2025 season. The current harvest is 25 bulls and hunters are currently in the field. To prevent overharvest, RM164 will be closed on 22 September 2025 at 11:59 p.m.
