EXPLANATION:

This Emergency Order extends the state resident moose season in Unit 18 covered under that portion south of the Eek River drainage and north of and including the Carter Bay drainage, under the registration permit hunt RM617. The Season will open November 5, 2025 and close on January 15, 2026. The bag limit for the Quinhagak hunt area is one bull, excluding male calves.

REGULATION:

Therefore, the following regulations in 5 AAC 85.045 (a) (16), HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR MOOSE are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective for hunting moose in Unit 18.

JUSTIFICATION:

The Alaska Board of Game (BOG) established a registration permit hunt in Unit 18, that portion south of the Eek River drainage and north of the Carter Bay drainage at the winter 2019 BOG meeting. This moose population occurs mainly in the Kanektok and Arolik River drainages and a survey was conducted in March 2024. A minimum of 273 moose were observed. The harvestable surplus for this hunt is 25 bull moose. To date, hunters have only reported harvesting 4 bulls and this population can support additional harvest. Hunters are reminded to report their harvest to the Bethel ADF&G office (907) 543-2839 or (907) 543-1678. Hunters that have already harvested a moose during this regulatory year (after July 1, 2025) are not eligible to participate in this hunt. Unsuccessful hunters and hunters that did not hunt need to report by January 31, 2026
