#### **EXPLANATION:**

This Emergency Order extends the state resident moose season in Unit 18, that portion that drains into Kuskokwim Bay south of the Carter Bay Drainage (including the Goodnews River drainage) under the registration permit hunt RM620. The season will open October 4, 2025 and go to October 15, 2025. The bag limit for the Goodnews hunt area is one bull moose.

Therefore, the following regulations in 5 AAC 85.045 (a) (16), HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR MOOSE are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective for hunting moose in Unit 18.

#### **JUSTIFICATION:**

The moose population in the Goodnews river hunt area is estimated between 400-450 moose. There was a 30 day season in September, but the quota of 40 bulls was not achieved. Members of the communities in the hunt area have reported a myriad of difficulties this hunting season and hunters have only reported harvesting 4 moose. Further, with only 28 permits issued for the fall 2025 season it is not possible to surpass the harvest objective. This extended season provides additional opportunity for hunters to harvest a moose. Hunters are asked to report their harvest within 5 days to the Bethel ADF&G office (907) 543-2839 or (907) 543-1678. Hunters that have already harvested a moose during this regulatory year (after July 1, 2025) are not eligible to participate in this hunt. Unsuccessful hunters and hunters that did not hunt need to report by October 31, 2025.
