EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the state of Alaska resident and nonresident mountain goat hunting season for that portion of Unit 1C north of Windham Bay, west of Spruce Creek at the head of Windham Bay, and south of Endicott Arm and Holkham Bay. This order takes effect at 11:59 pm, Saturday, August 8, 2026.

REGULATORY TEXT:

Therefore, the provisions of 5 AAC 85.040, HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR GOAT, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective for hunting mountain goats in Unit 1(C):

This portion of the Unit 1C Endicott Arm hunt has a small number of goats that can support the harvest of 1 goat point or 1 animal. As of August 7, 2026, one male goat was harvested in this area. Thus, the area is being closed by Emergency Order effective at 11:59 pm, Saturday, August 8, 2026.
