

# Hunting and Trapping Emergency Order

## **EXPLANATION:**

This emergency order closes the caribou season in southern Unit 25B, because there is no Fortymile Caribou Herd harvest allocated to Unit 25B.

Some of the Fortymile Caribou Herd made a movement north of the Yukon River into southern Unit 25B, prompting a closure of the caribou season in a portion of Unit 25B. Harvest management of the Fortymile Caribou Herd is guided by the Fortymile Caribou Herd Harvest Plan (harvest plan). This harvest plan allocates all available Fortymile Herd harvest to a hunt area south of the Yukon River in portions of Units 20B, 20D, 20F and 25C and all of Unit 20E. Currently there is no Fortymile Caribou Herd harvest allocated to Unit 25B.

No other caribou hunting regulations in Unit 25 are affected by this emergency order.

## **REGULATION:**

Therefore, the following regulations in **5AAC 85.025(a)(20), HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR CARIBOU**, is superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective for hunting caribou:



No other caribou hunting regulations in Unit 25 are affected by this emergency order.



**JUSTIFICATION:**

The Alaska Board of Game endorsed the Fortymile Caribou Herd Harvest Plan (harvest plan) as a means of guiding harvest of the herd. The harvest plan allocates all available Fortymile Herd harvest to a hunt area south of the Yukon River in portions of Units 20B, 20D and 25C and all of Unit 20E. Currently there is no Fortymile Caribou Herd harvest allocated to Unit 25B. Seasons and bag limits in Unit 25B are in place to provide opportunity for the Porcupine Caribou Herd, and there are currently no Porcupine Caribou within the portion of Unit 25B that will be closed, so hunting opportunity for Porcupine Caribou will not be impacted.
