**ALASKA BOARD OF GAME
 November 19, 2021 – Web Conference**

Preliminary Meeting Summary

The Board of Game (board) met by web-conference on Friday, November 19, 2021. Seven board members were present: Chairman Stosh Hoffman, acting vice-chair Orville Huntington, Jerry Burnett, Al Barrette, Jake Fletcher, Lynn Keogh and James Cooney. The purpose of the meeting was to address seven Agenda Changes Requests received by the November 1, 2021 deadline for consideration at the board meetings scheduled for January and March 2022.
