

## Unit 17 Bristol Bay

Unit 17: Drainages into Bristol Bay and the Bering Sea between Etolin Point and Cape Newenham, and all islands between these points, including Hagemeister Island and the Walrus Islands and all seaward waters and lands within three miles of these coastlines;

Unit 17A: that portion of Unit 17 in the drainages between Cape Newenham and Cape Constantine, and Hagemeister Island and the Walrus Islands;

Unit 17B: that portion of Unit 17 in the Nushagak River drainage upstream from and including the Mulchatna River drainage, and the Wood River drainage upstream from the outlet of Lake Beverley;

Unit 17C: the remainder of Unit 17.

A portion of this unit is within a predator control area; see predator control supplement for special regulations online at hunt.alaska.gov.
