Staying Safe In Bear Country Class!

If you spend much time outdoors in Alaska, you stand a good chance of encountering a bear. This class will cover:

- *Bear Awareness & Safety*
- *Firearm Safety*
- *Shotgun Operation & Ammunition*
- *Shooting Fundamentals*



COST:

- *\$100 includes instruction, safety equipment, program materials, firearm use, ammunition and refreshments.*

PREREQUISITES:

- *No firearm experience necessary*
- *Participant must be legally able to possess a firearm*
- *Pregnant or nursing women should contact physician before registering*



CLASS NOTES:

- *Part of this class is conducted as a live fire exercise on the range and can be physically demanding and challenging. It is recommended that participants have the ability to hold a shotgun and withstand minimal recoil.*
- *Class will be held at the Rabbit Creek Shooting Park 6:00—10:00 PM on both nights.*
