





Bycatch Innovation Research Fund

- State of Alaska seeds fund with \$2M
- Managed by UAF ABEC
- Board of Advisors led by industry
 - Identify stakeholder priorities
 - Create “challenges”
- To apply, researchers partner with industry stakeholders
- Funds are competitively awarded
- Implementation of projects
- Monitor and verify for outcomes and reporting
- Sustainment of funding from additional sources
 - State funds used as match for federal grants



Addressing Bycatch Through Innovation Research



Successful Precedent

 - UAF partnership with US DOI BOEM
 - Study coastal topics associated with the development of natural resources in Alaska's outer continental shelf
