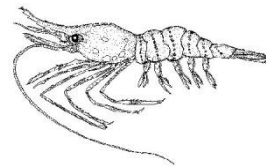

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS FOR PWS SHRIMP POT FISHERY

- 1) **Pre-trip check in:** All vessels must contact ADF&G **before each trip** at 907-226-3474 (226-FISH) no earlier than 24 hours **before fishing** and report the items as listed on the provided Pre-trip Information Form.
- 2) **Logbook pages:** Logbook pages are issued with registration and must be on board the vessel, completed daily, made available to ADF&G staff or Alaska Wildlife Troopers upon request, and submitted to ADF&G no more than 7 days after landing.
- 3) **Catcher-processors:** Report daily harvest electronically or to 907-226-3474 (226-FISH).

4) Landing requirements:

A) **Prior to landing shrimp** (removing from vessel):

- i. **All vessels** must contact ADF&G Homer electronically or at 907-226-3474 (226-FISH) and report the items as listed on the provided Harvest Reporting Form.
- ii. **Catcher-sellers and catcher-processors** must complete an ADF&G fish ticket.

B) **All other catcher vessels:** Fish tickets must be completed by the first purchaser at the time of landing.

NOTE: Shrimp retained for personal use must be reported on an ADF&G fish ticket.

C) Fish tickets and logbook pages must be received by ADF&G Homer no more than 7 days after landing.
