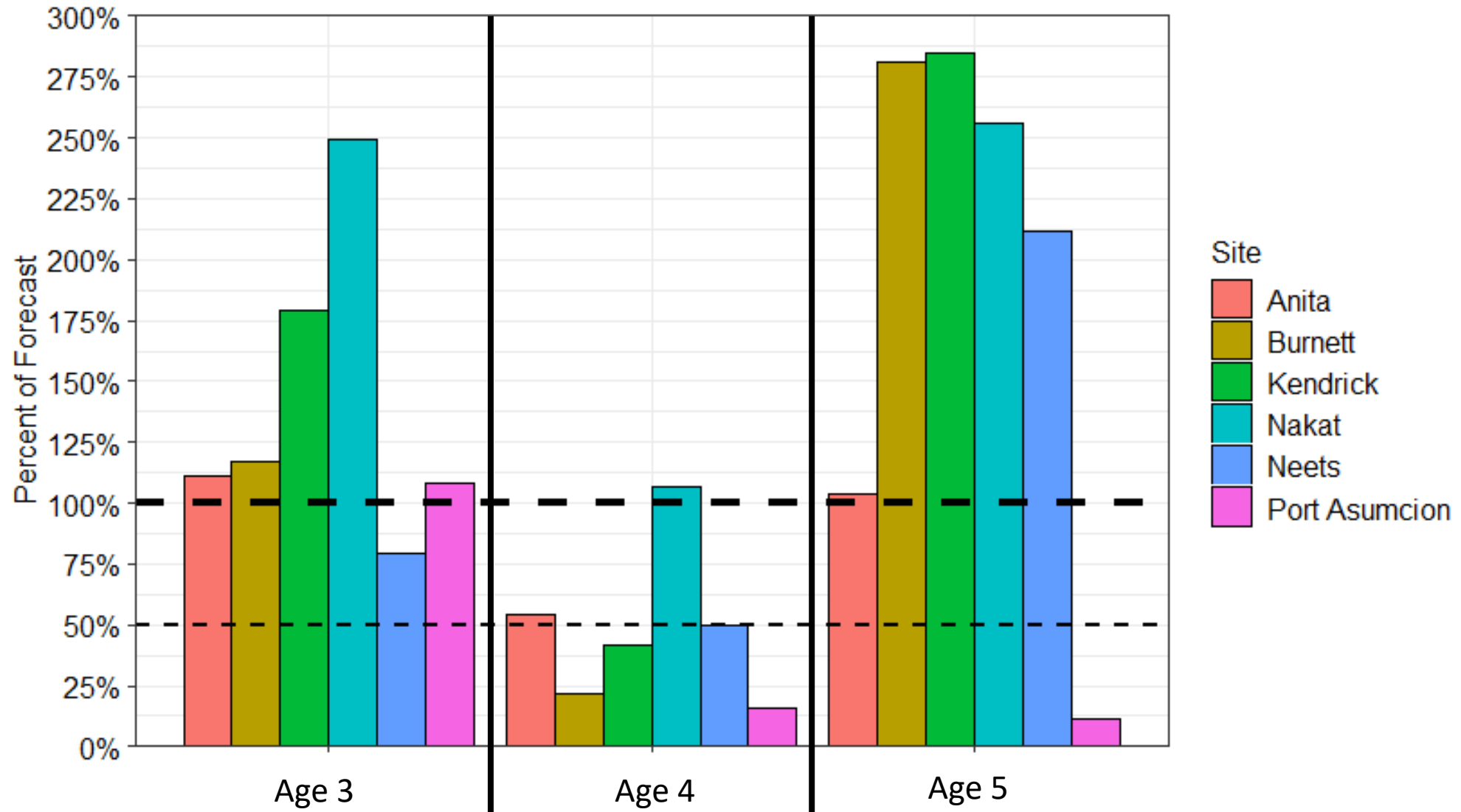


SSRAA Summer Chum Return, 2015-2024



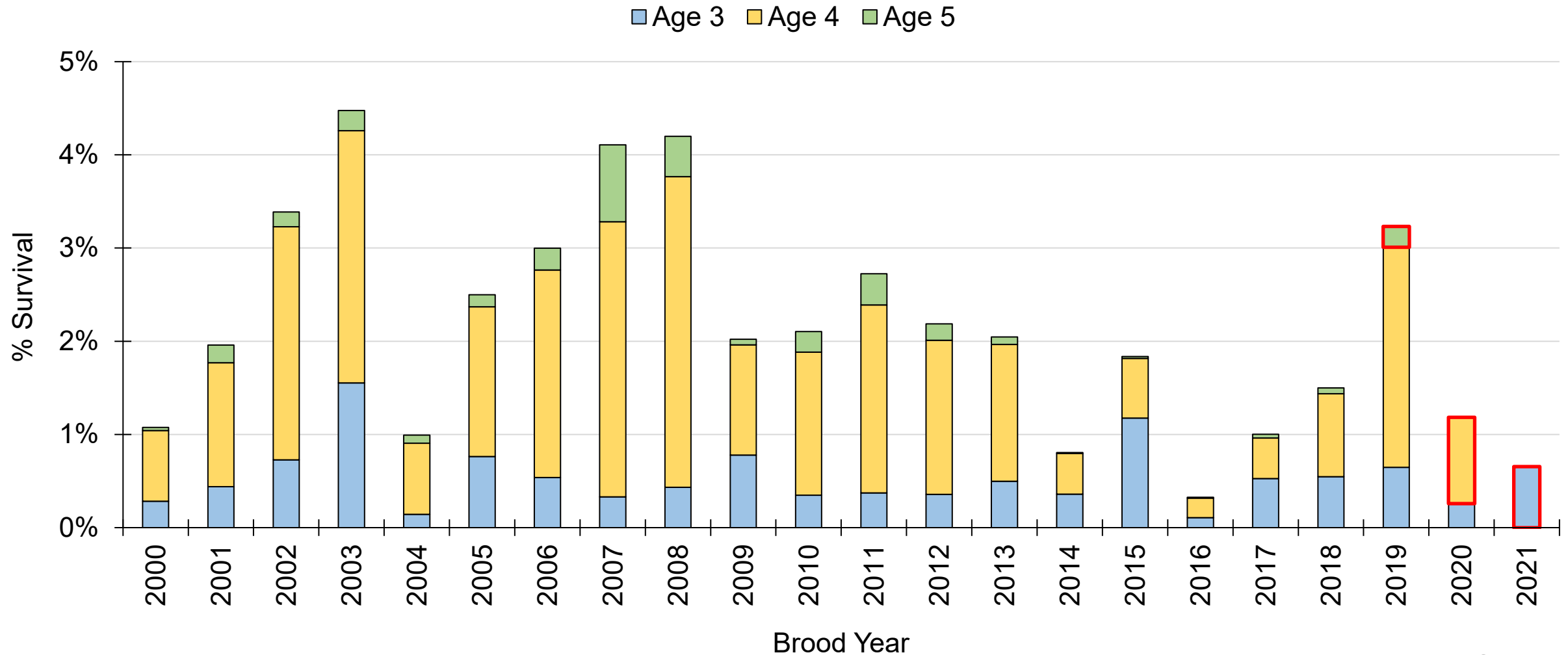


SSRAA Summer Chum Forecast vs. Actual



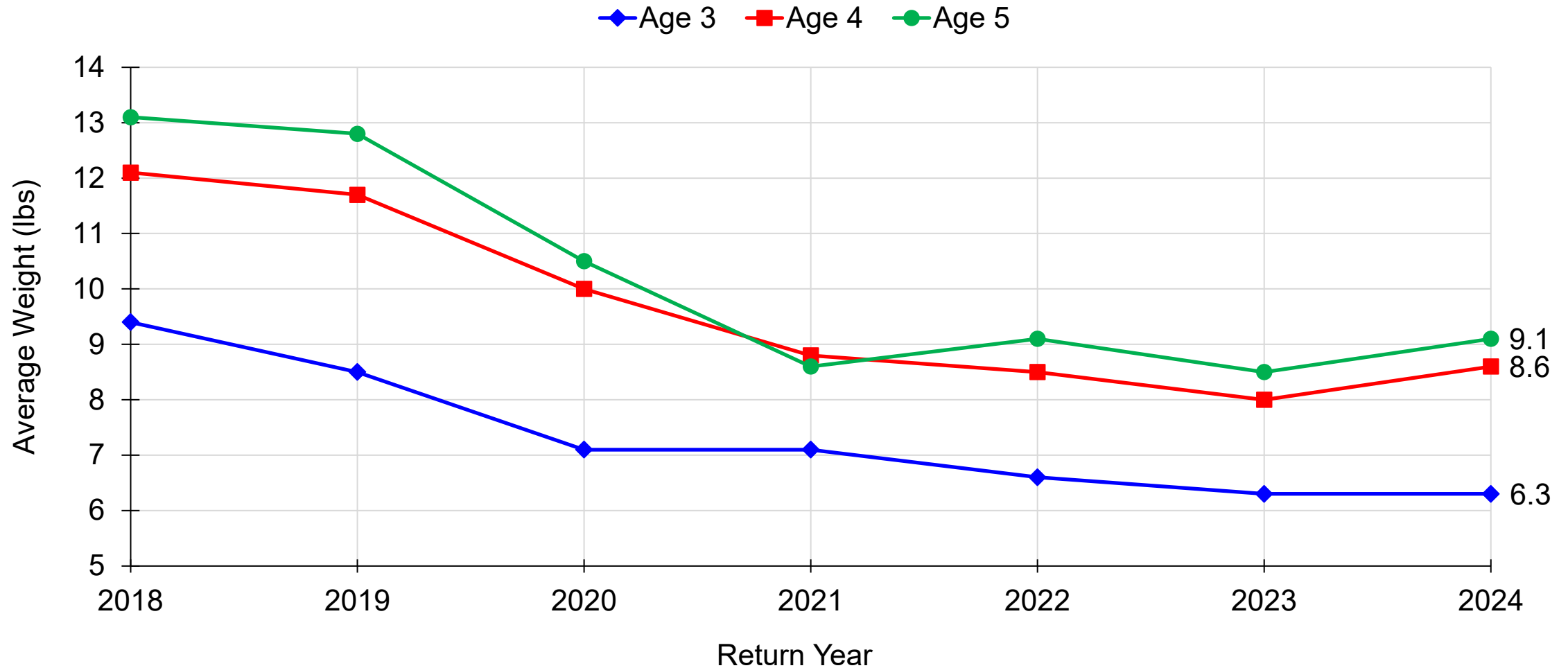


Percent Survival by Age-Class

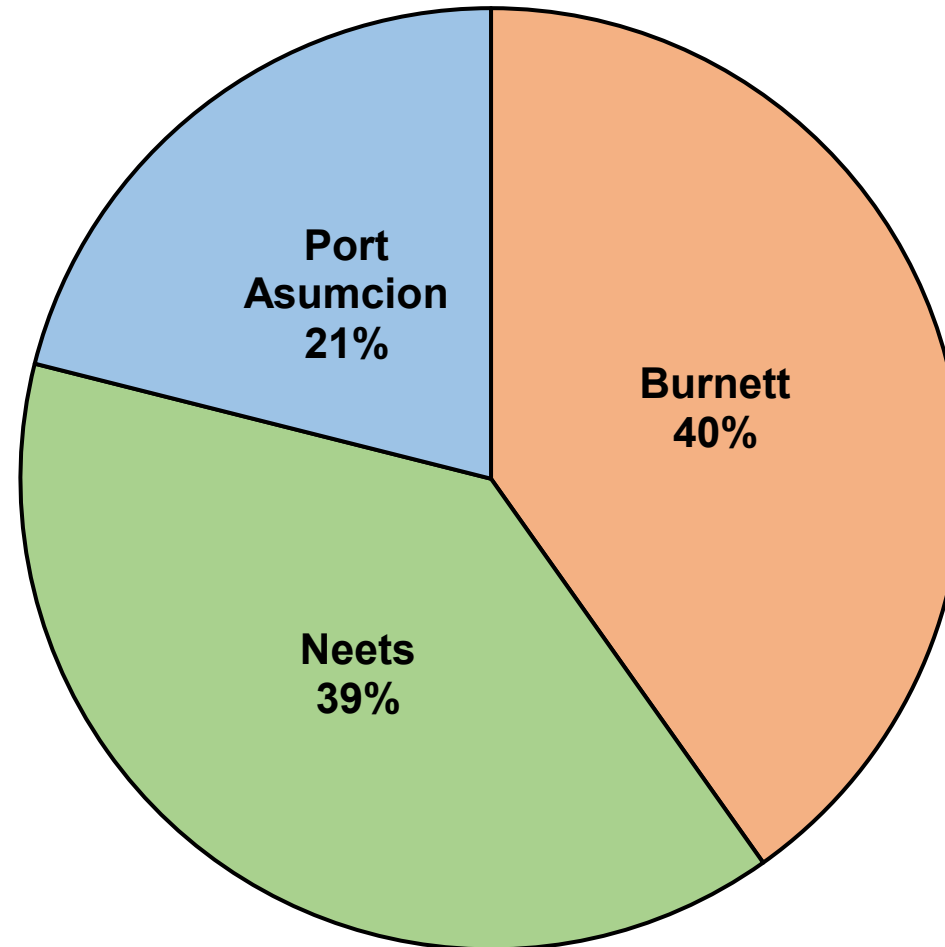




SSRAA Summer Chum Average Weights

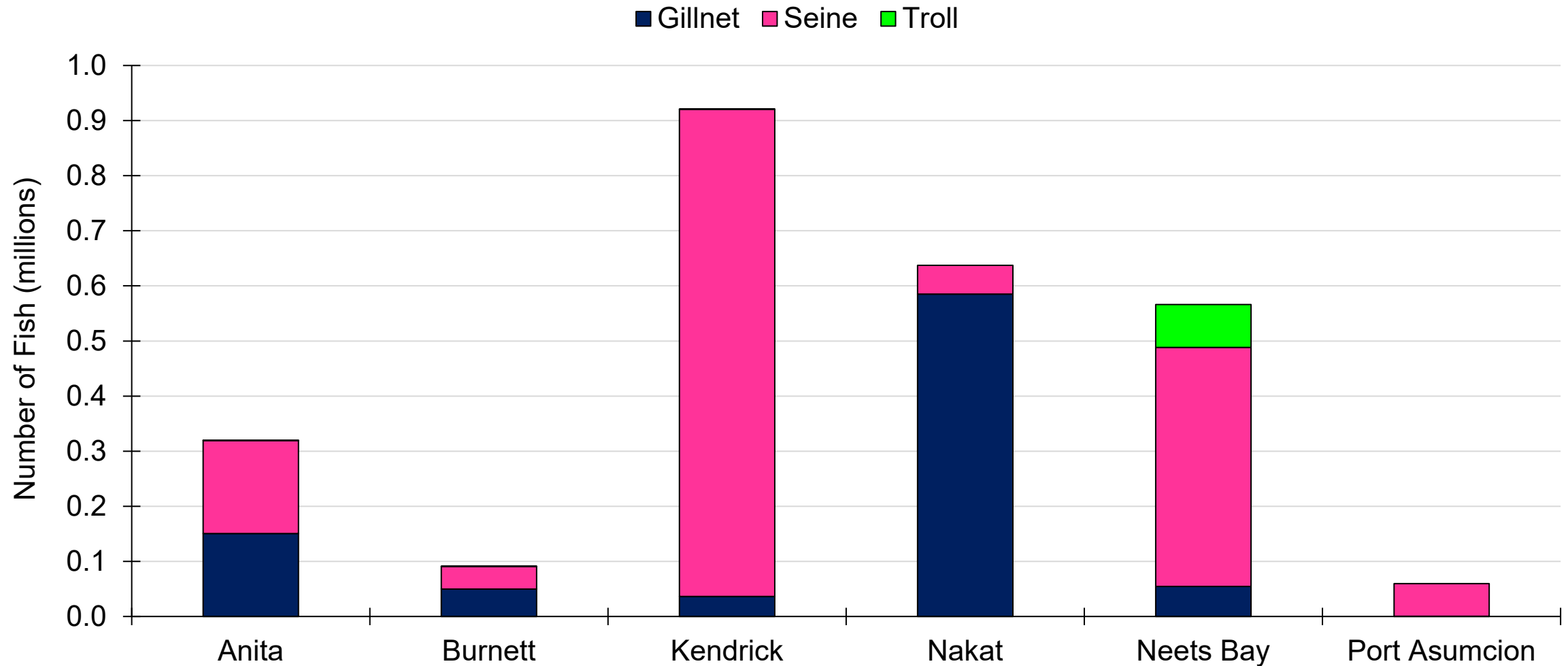


SSRAA Summer Chum Cost Recovery



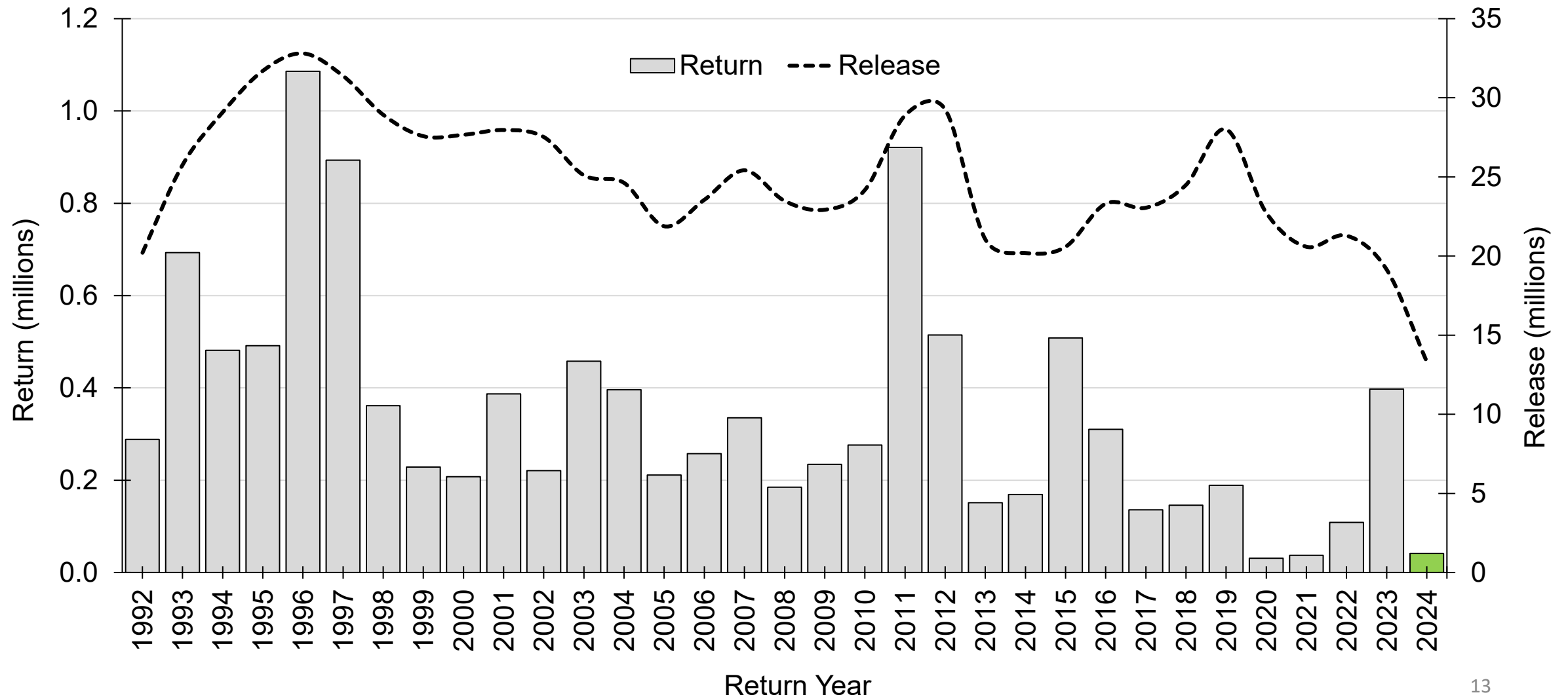


SSRAA Summer Chum Catch Share



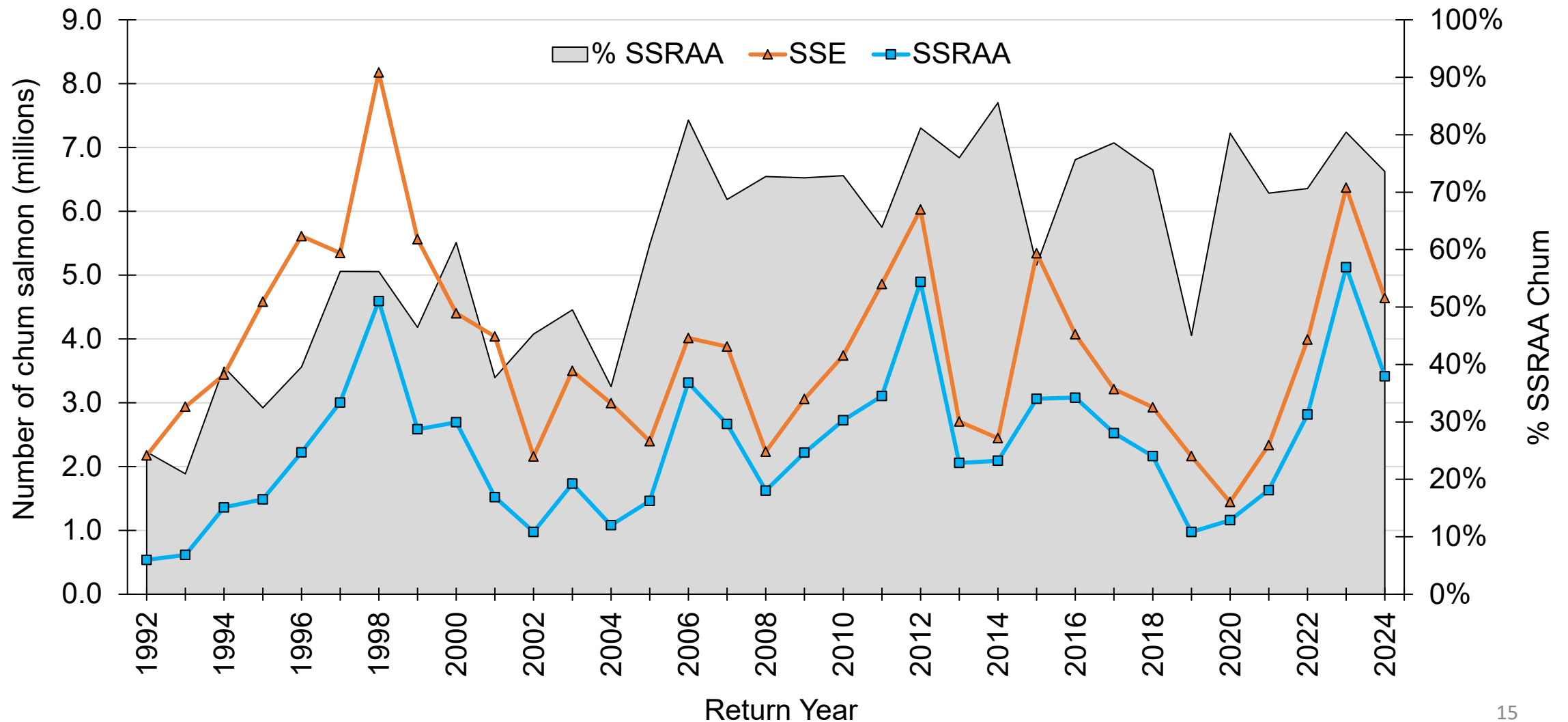

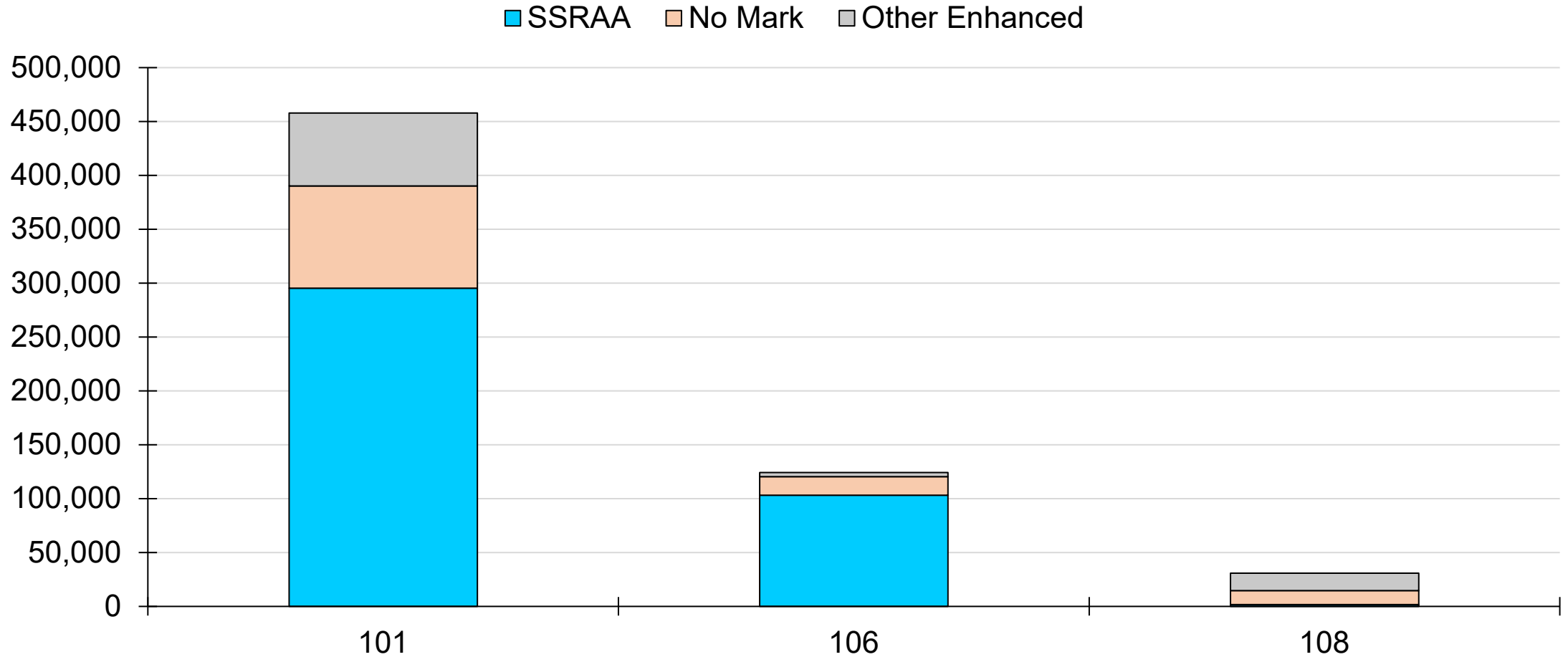


SSE AK Chum Salmon Harvest, 1992-2024





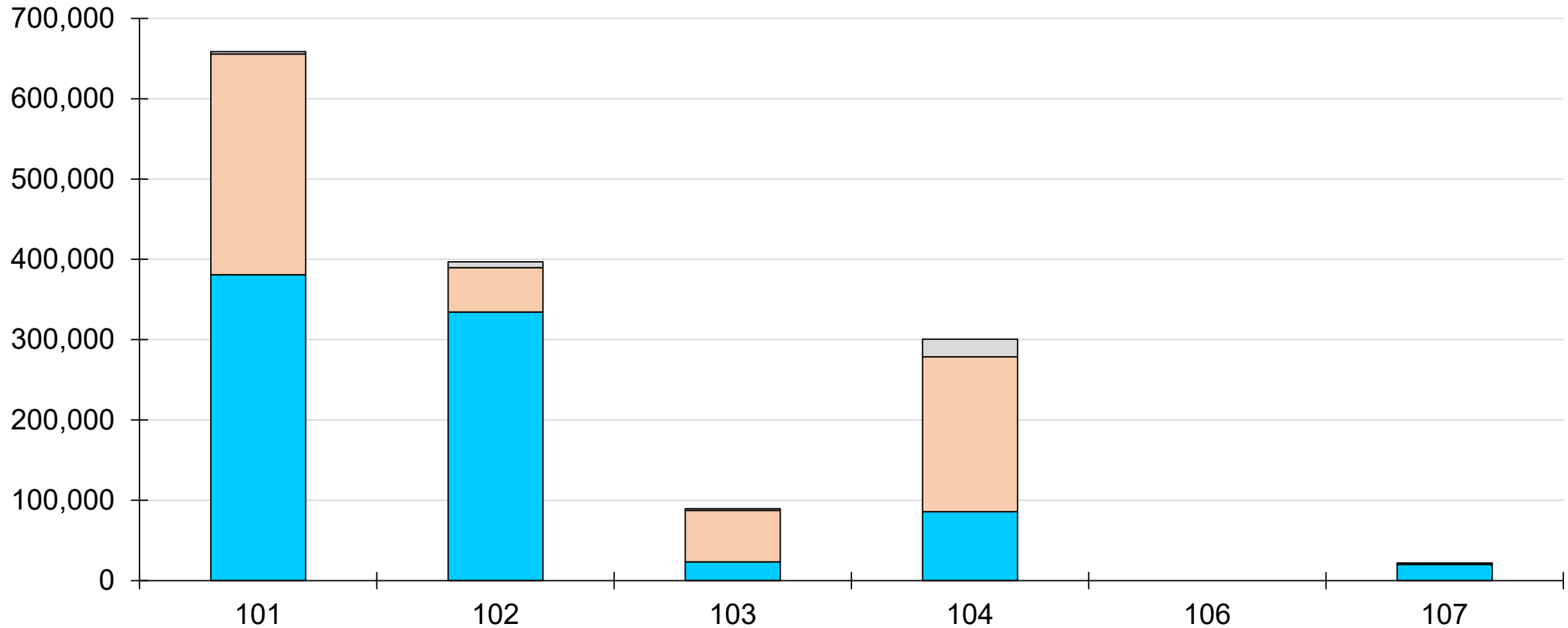
Gillnet Chum Catch Composition D1-8

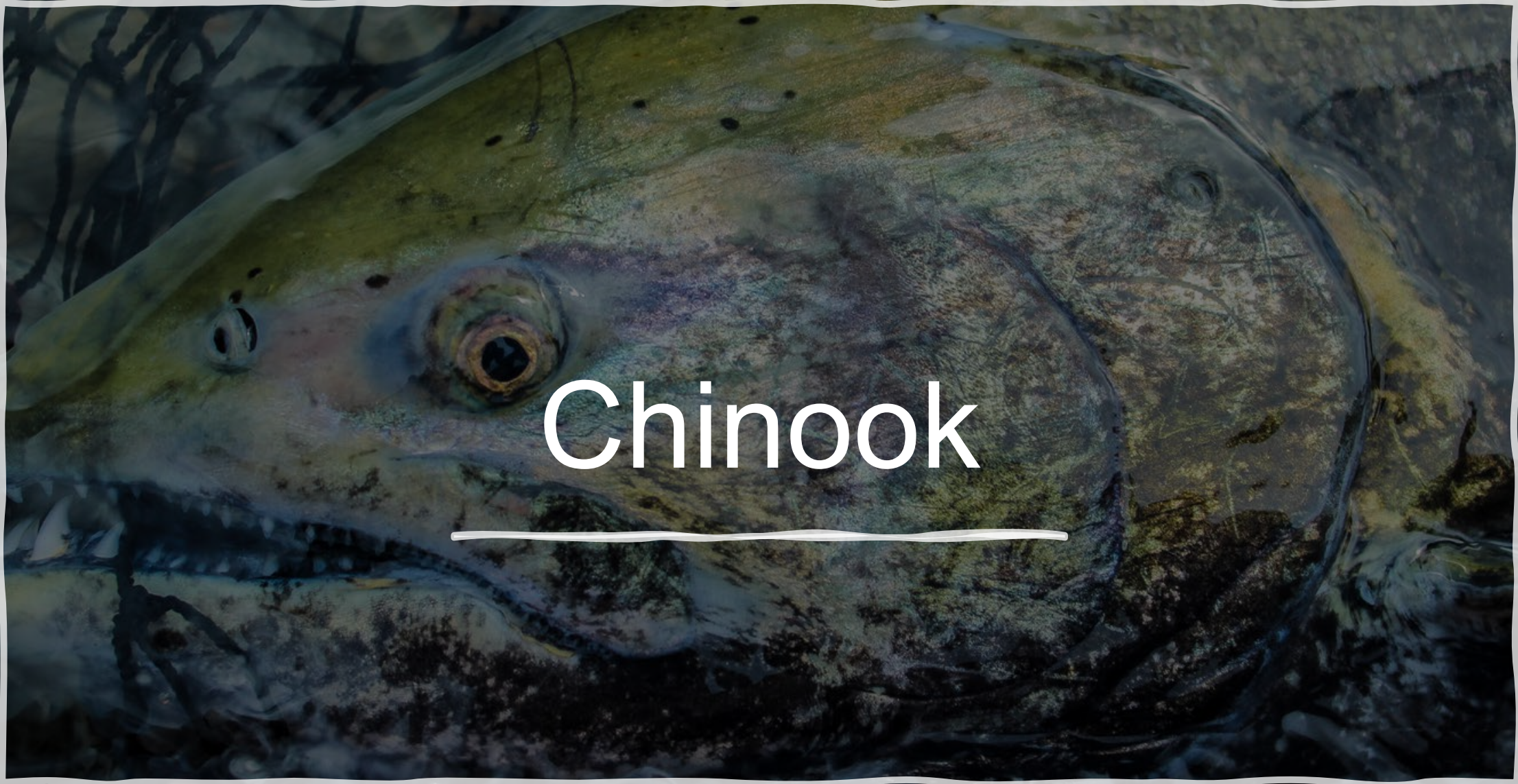




Seine Chum Catch Composition D1-8

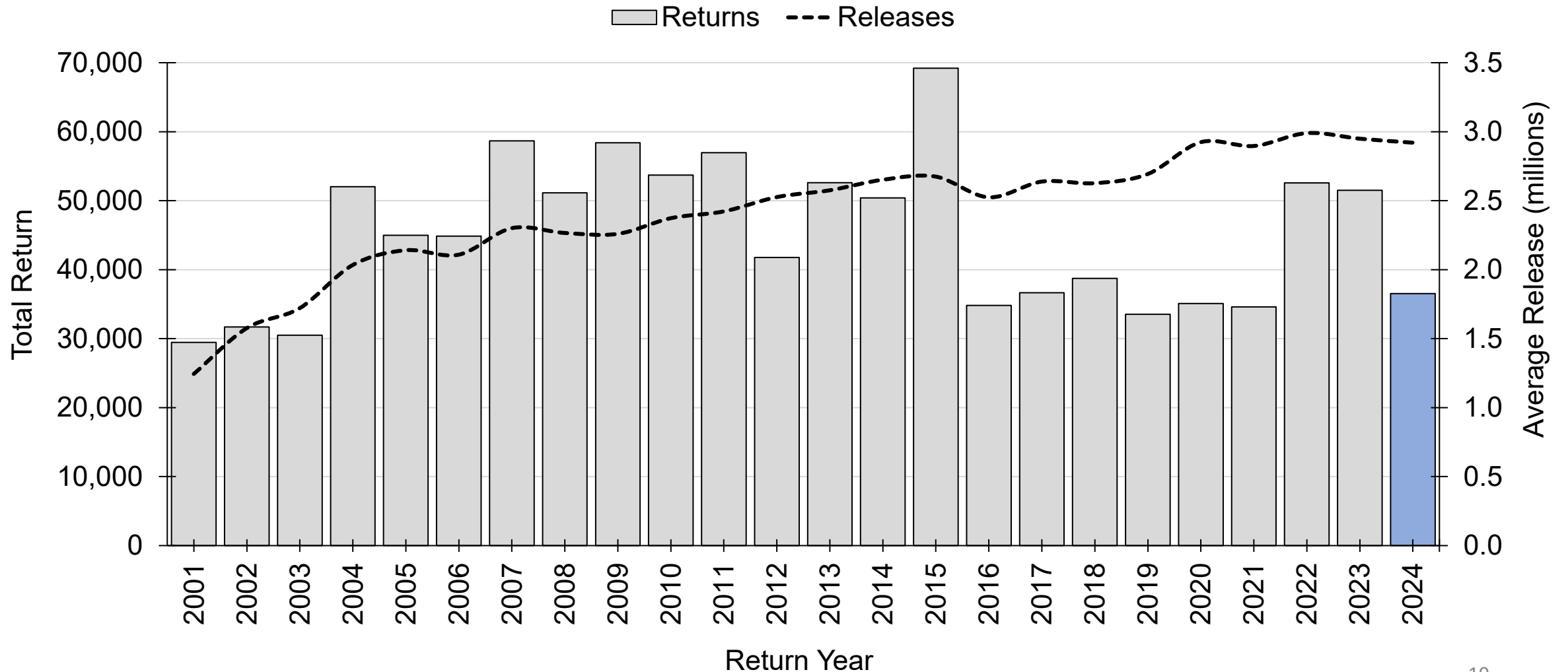

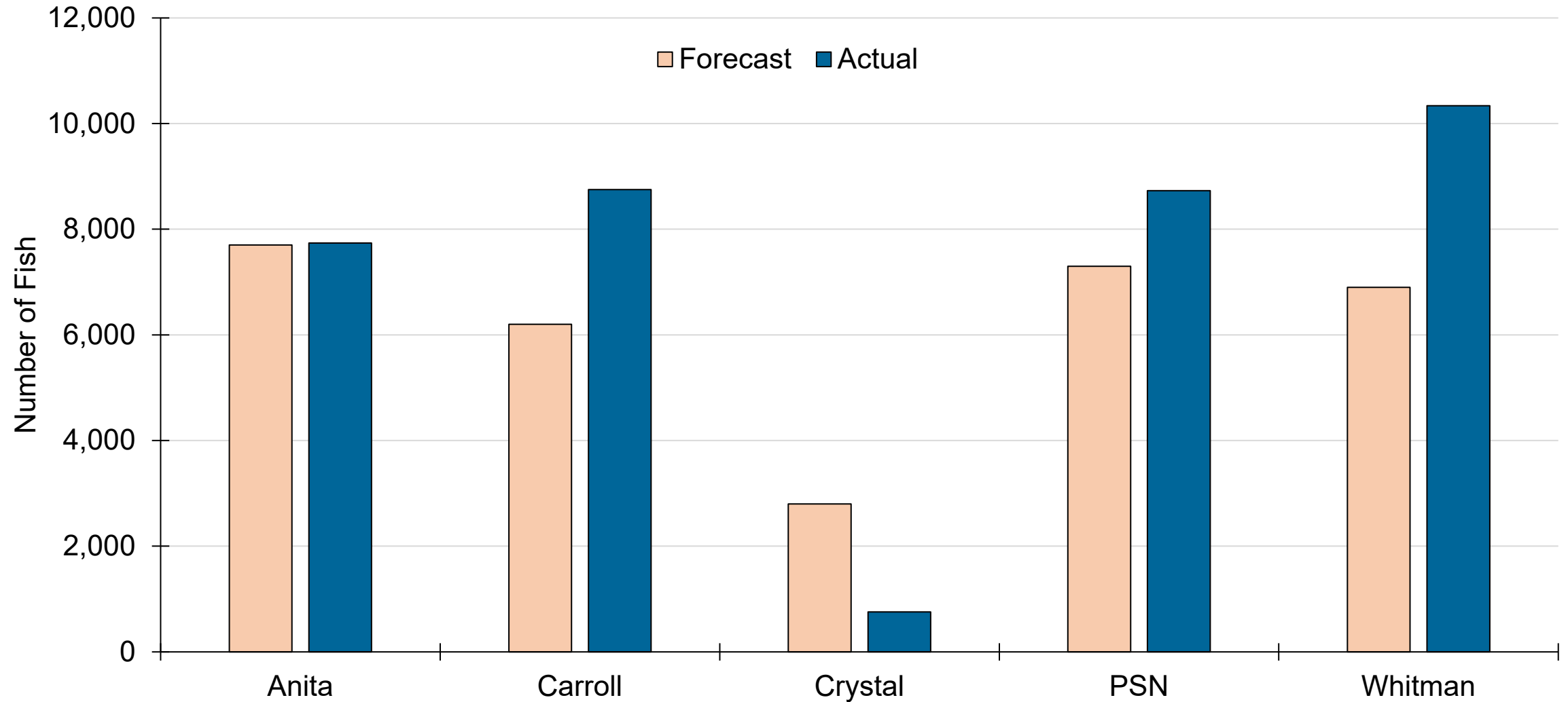

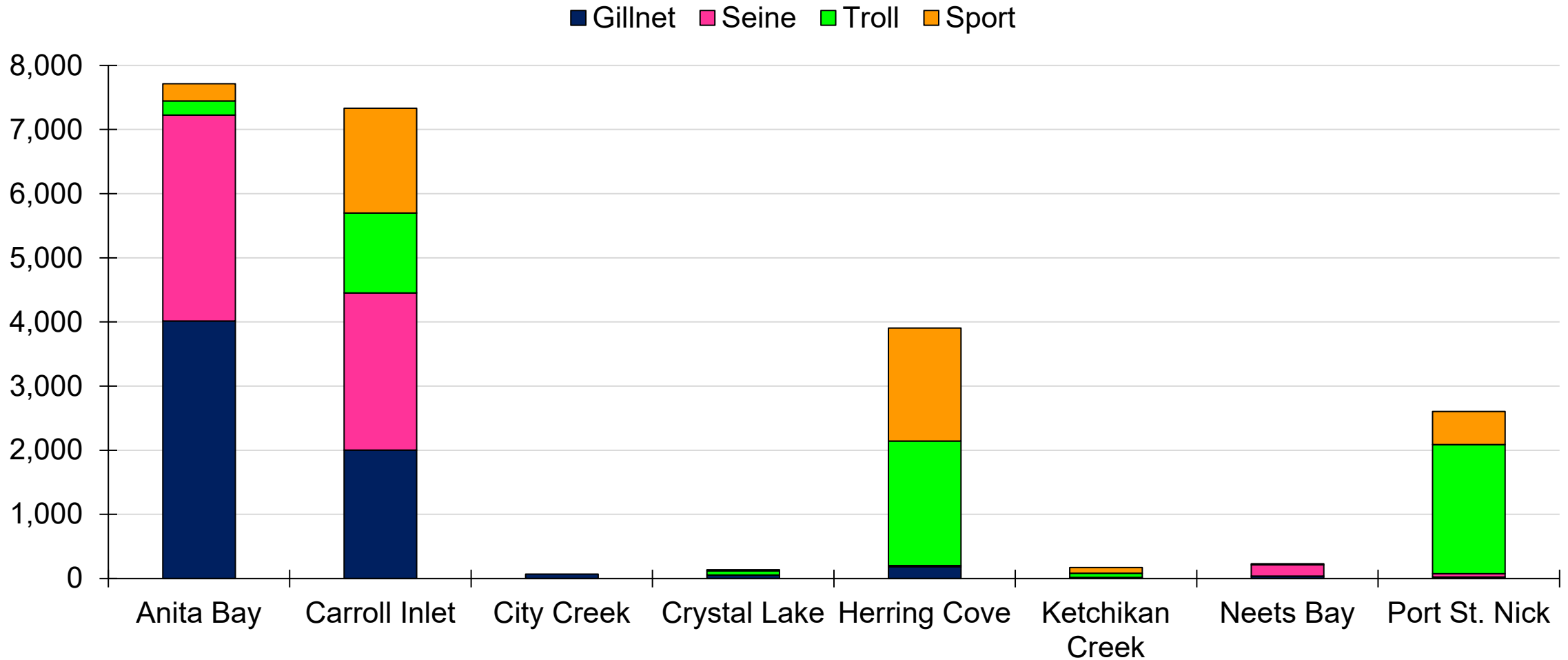


2024 Chinook Forecast vs. Actual

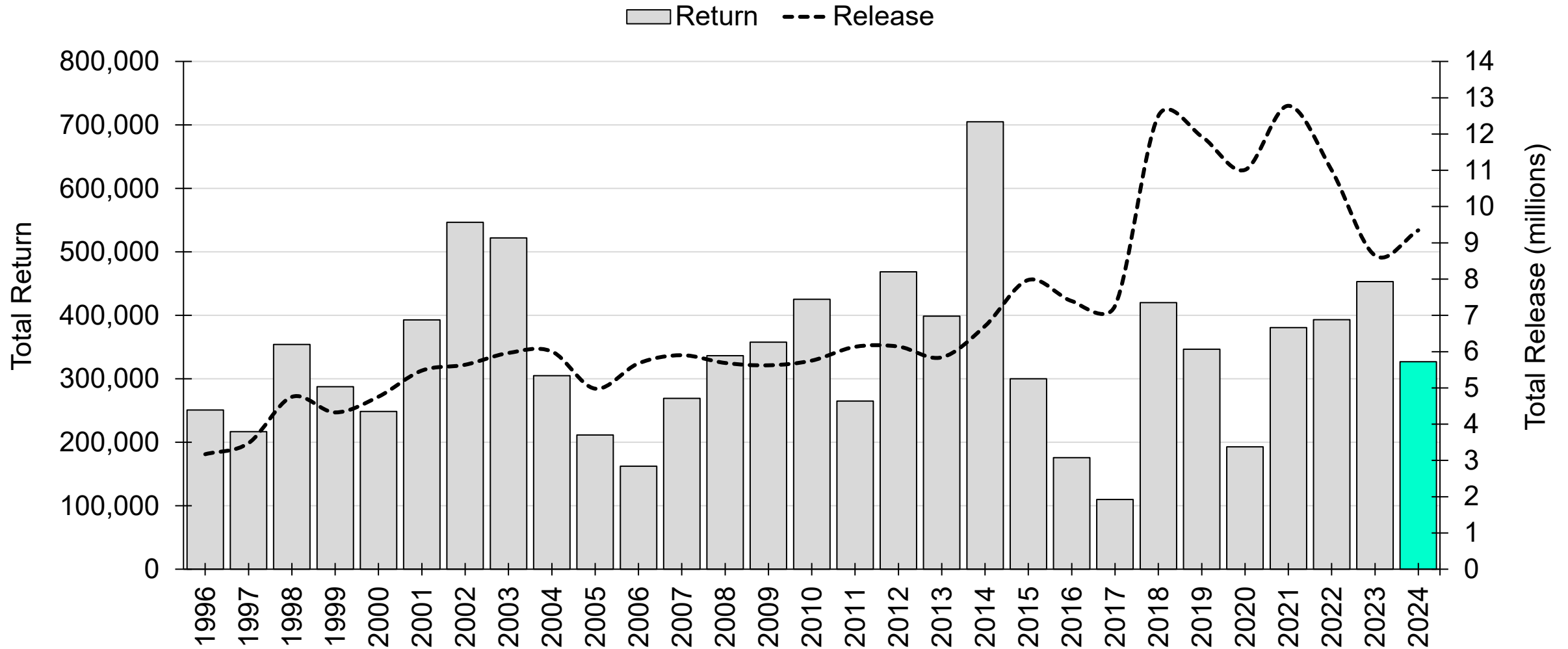

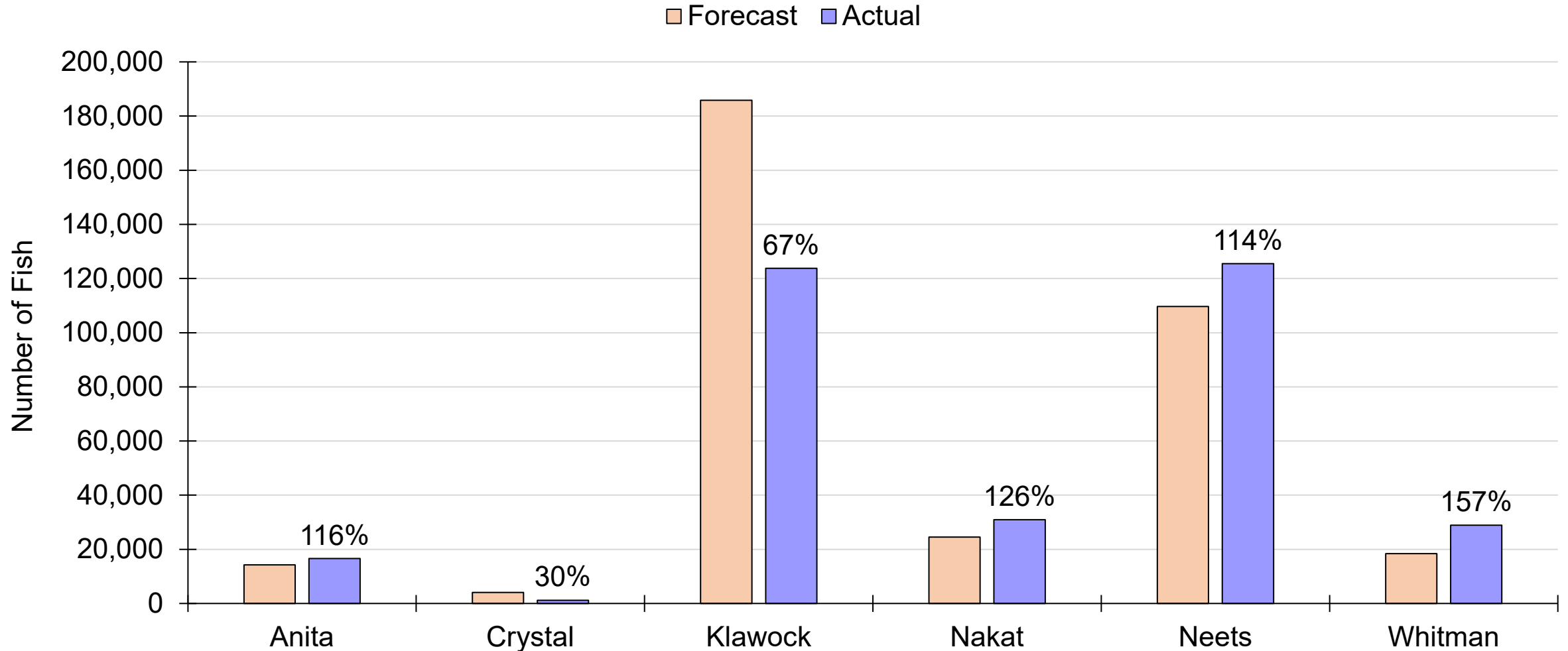

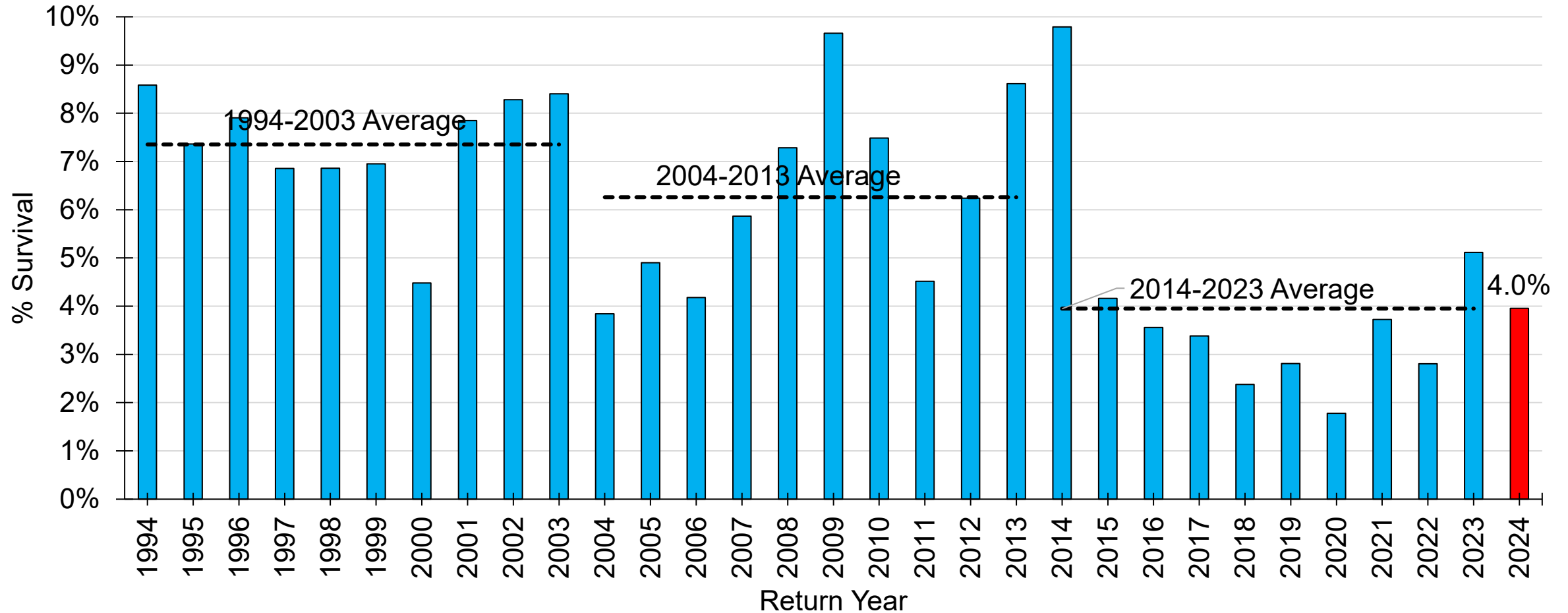


2024 Coho Forecast vs. Actual



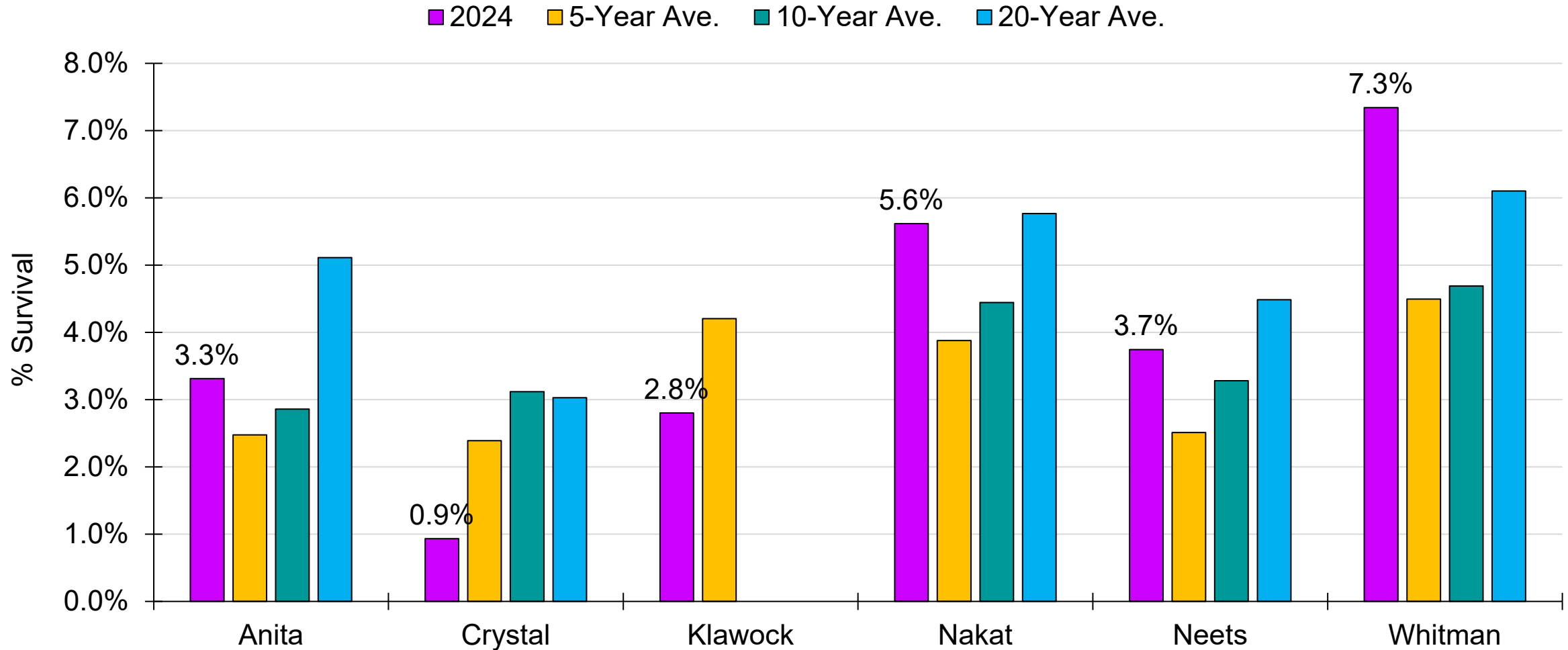


2024 Coho Survival



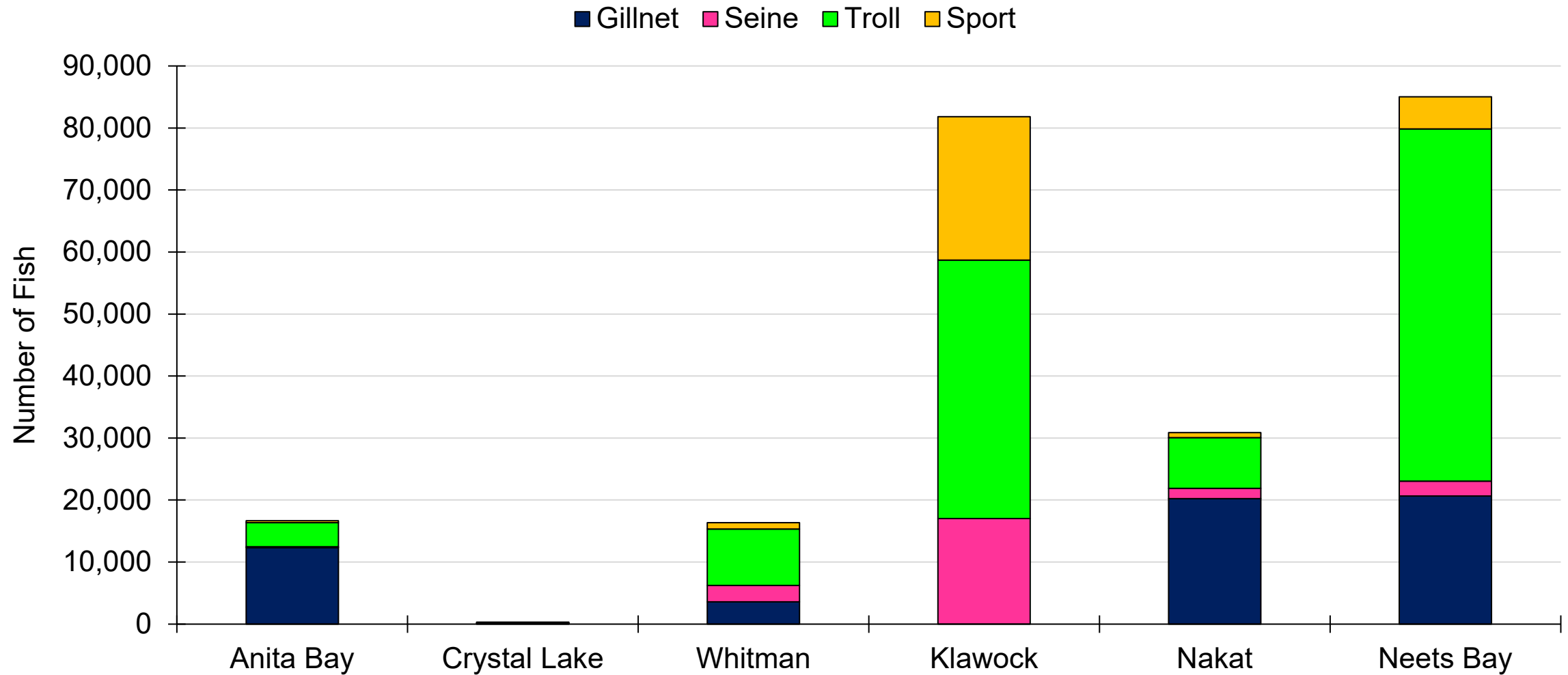

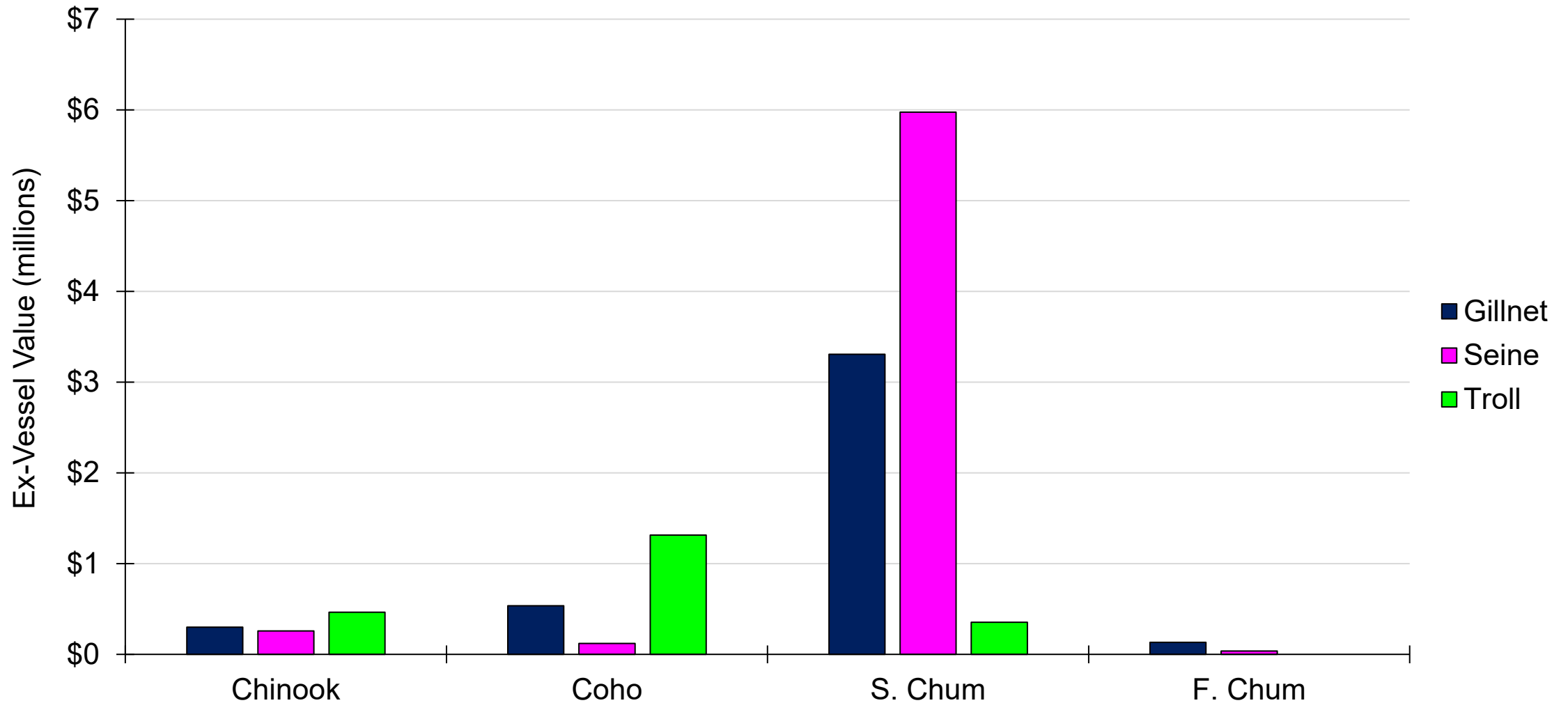

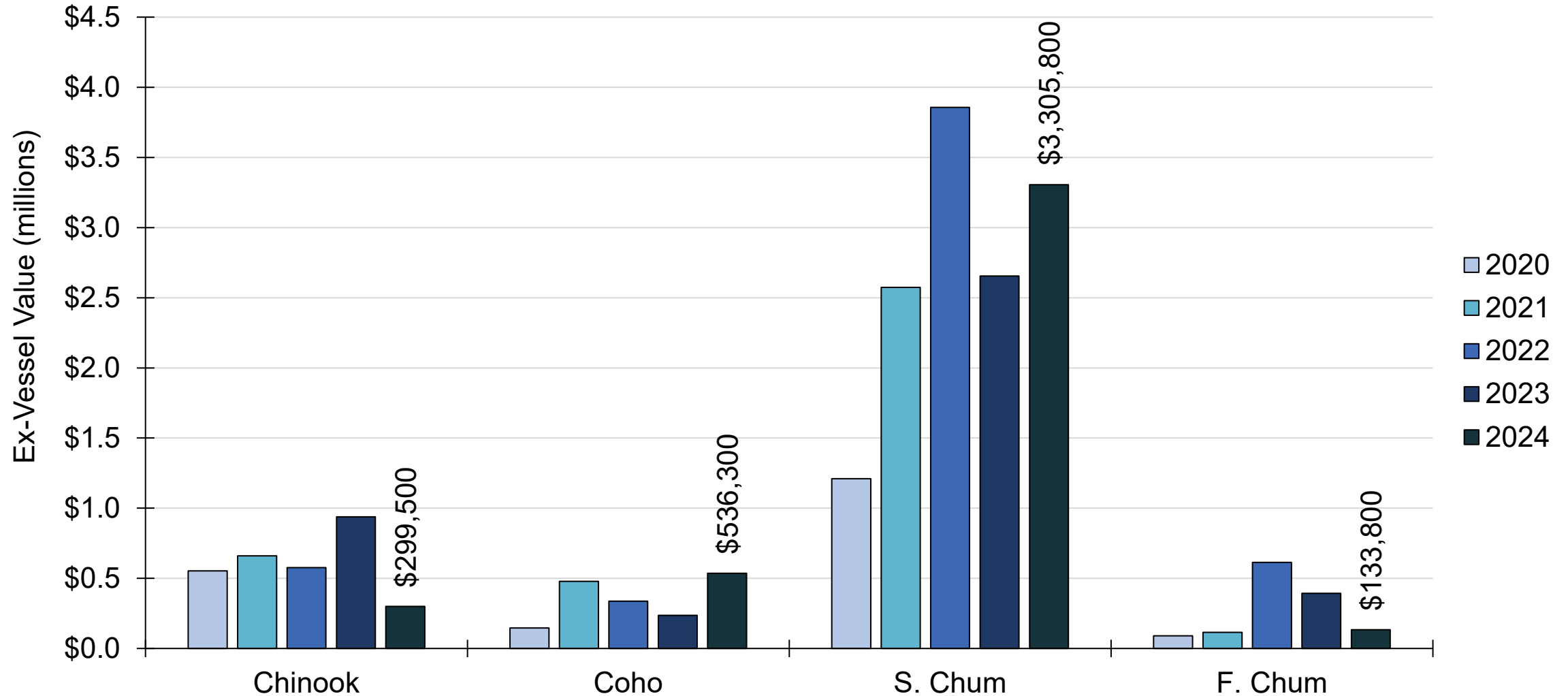


2024 SSRAA Value Estimates



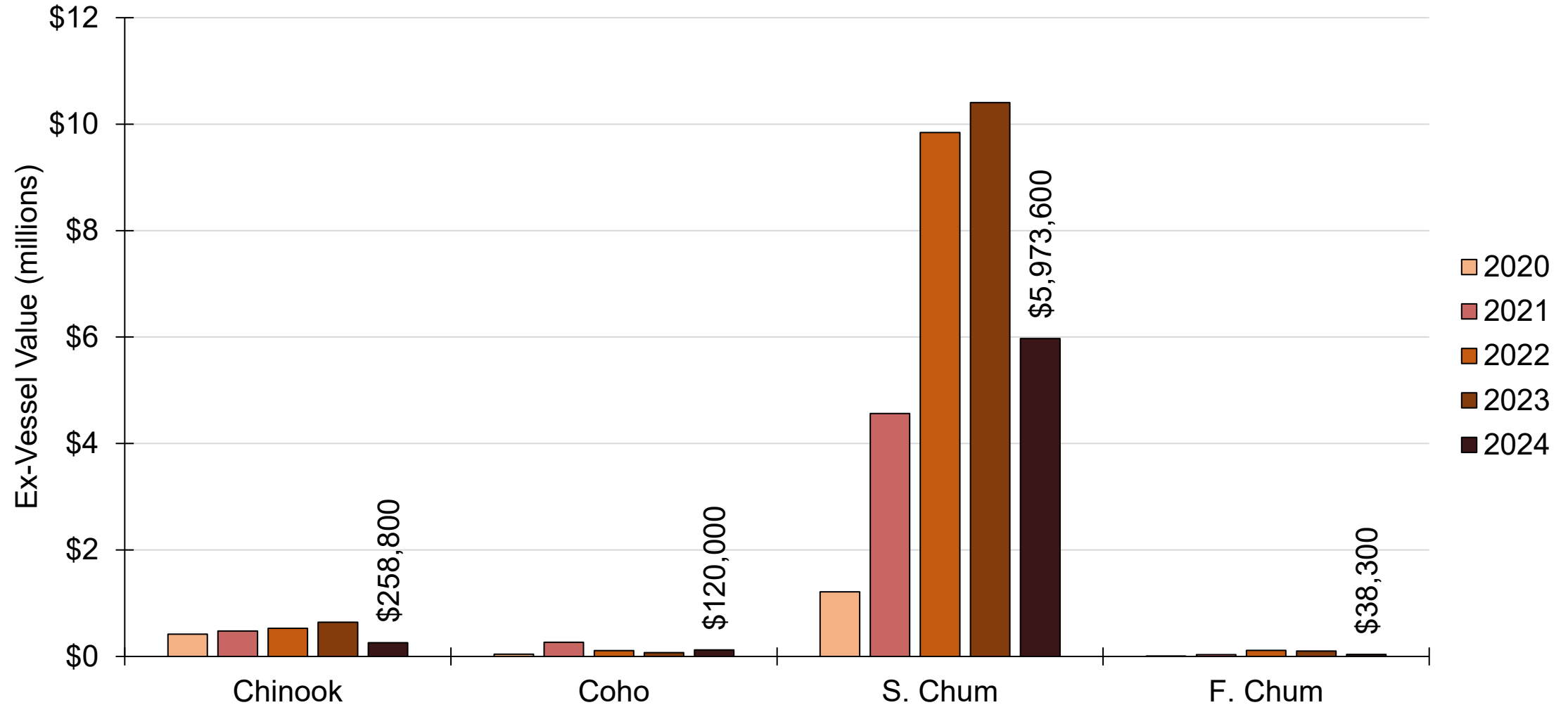


SSRAA Value Estimates - Gillnet



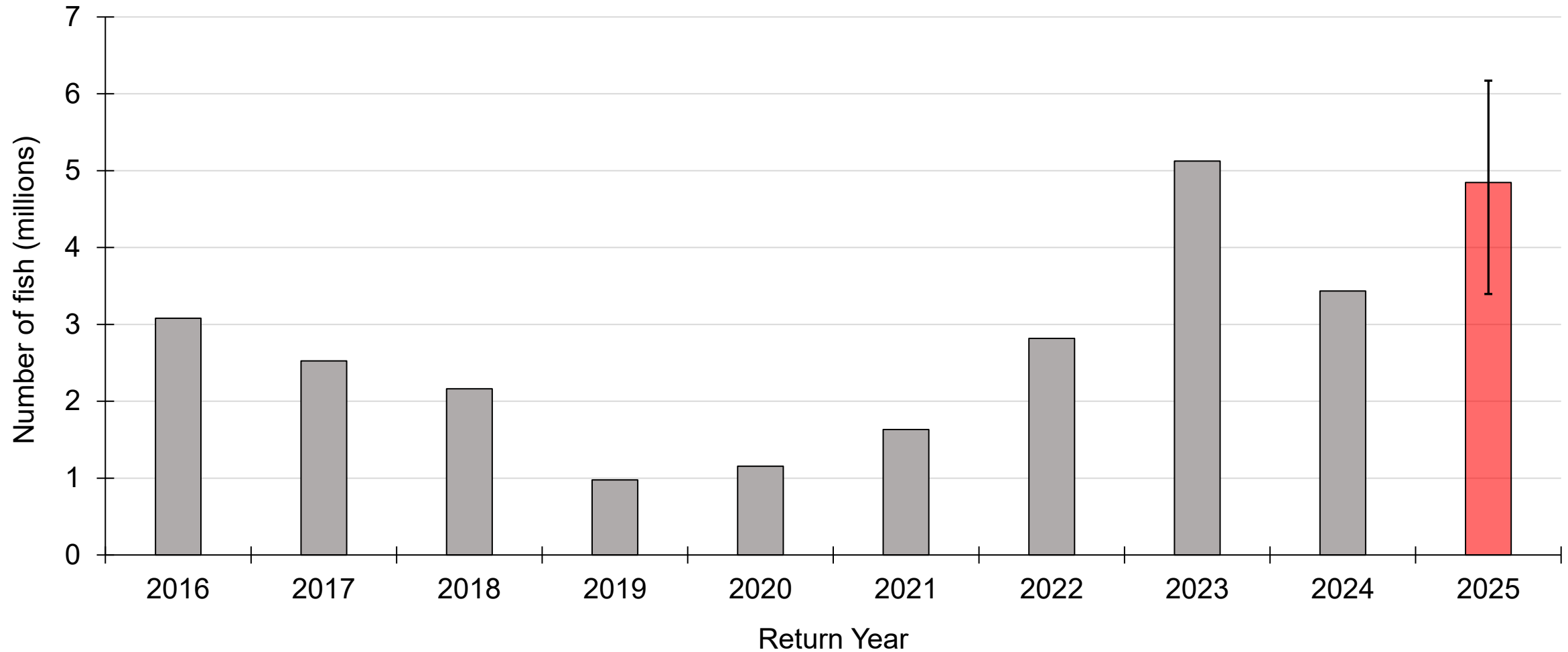


SSRAA Value Estimates - Seine

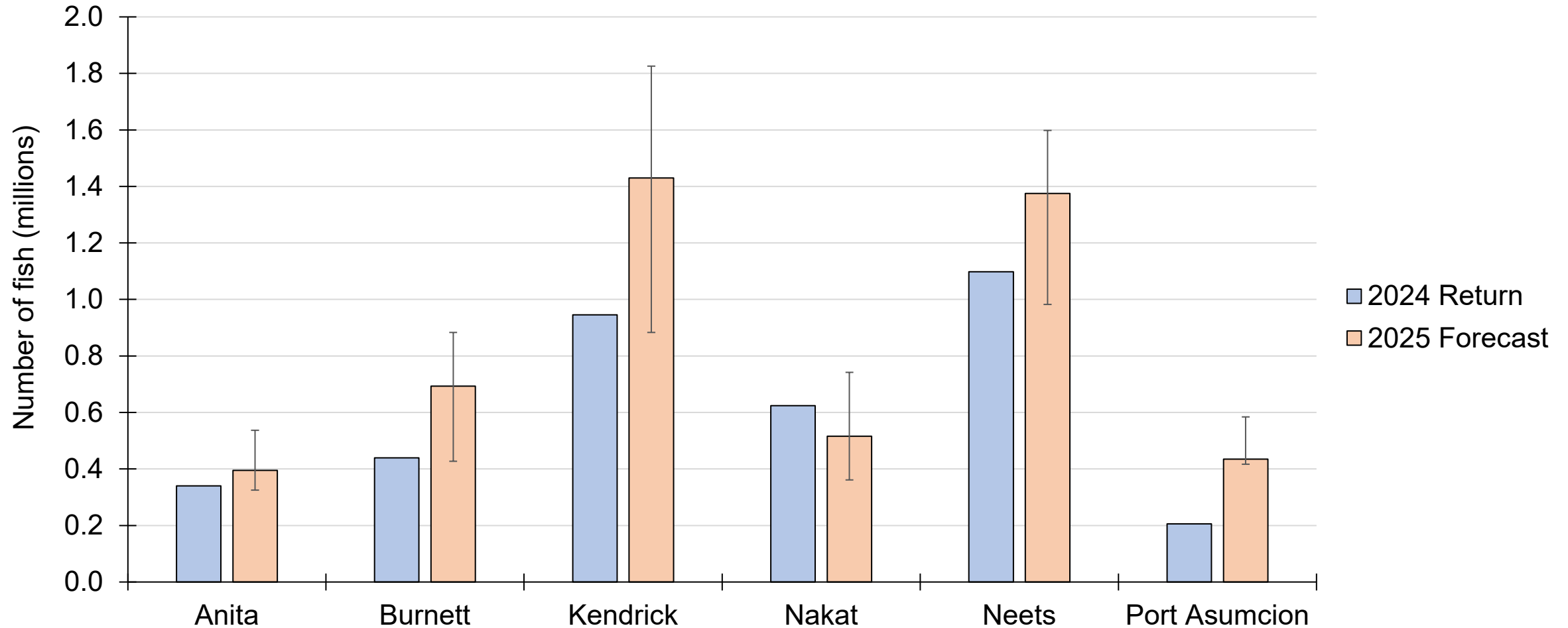

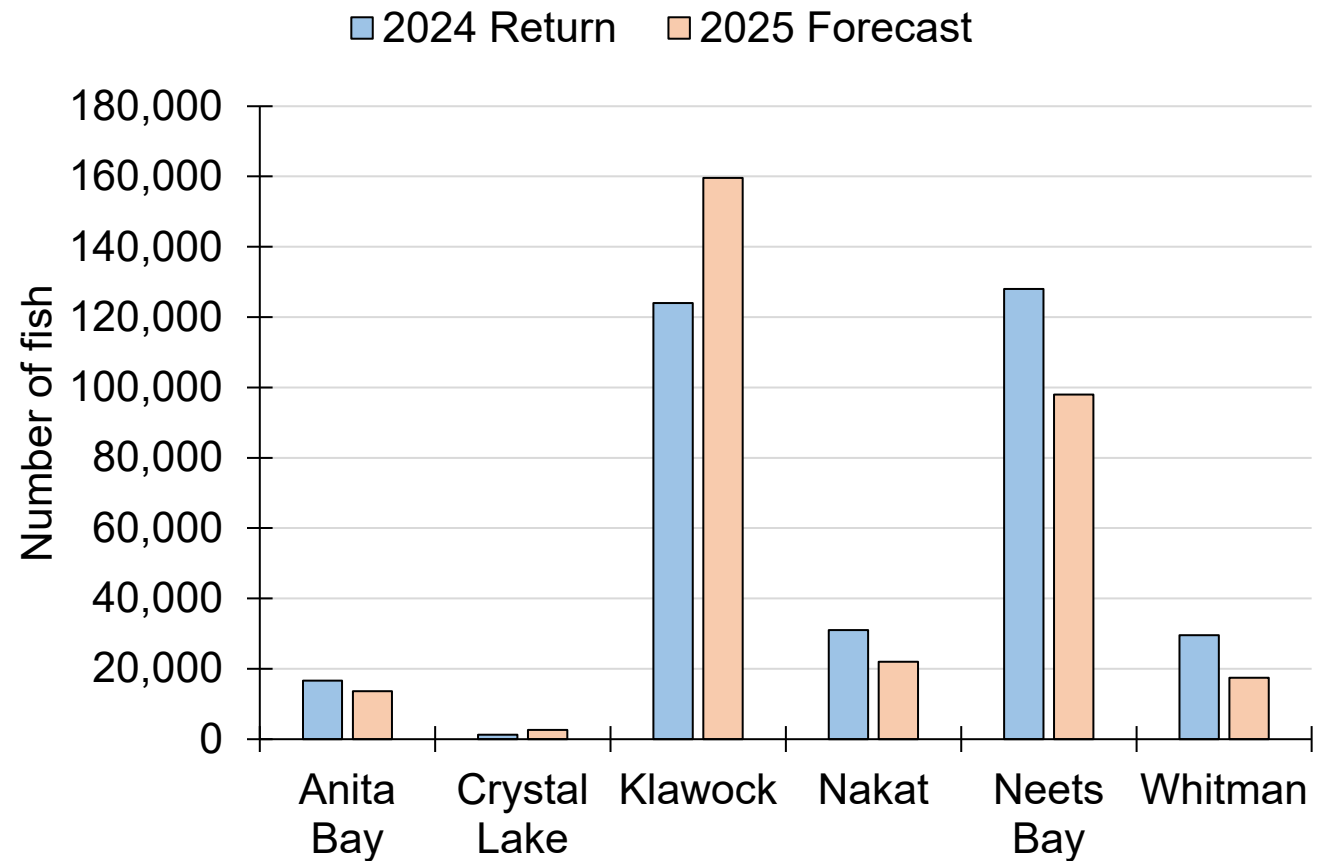

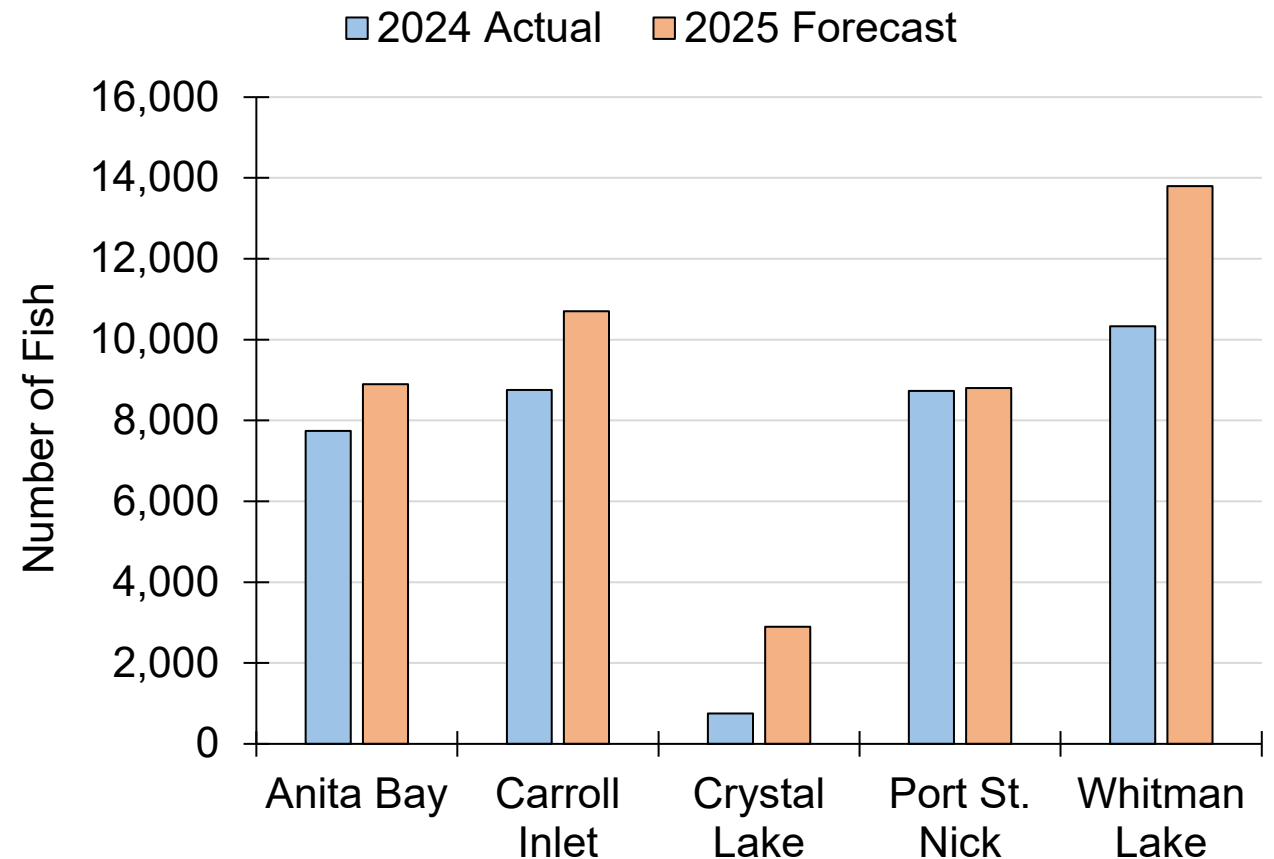
