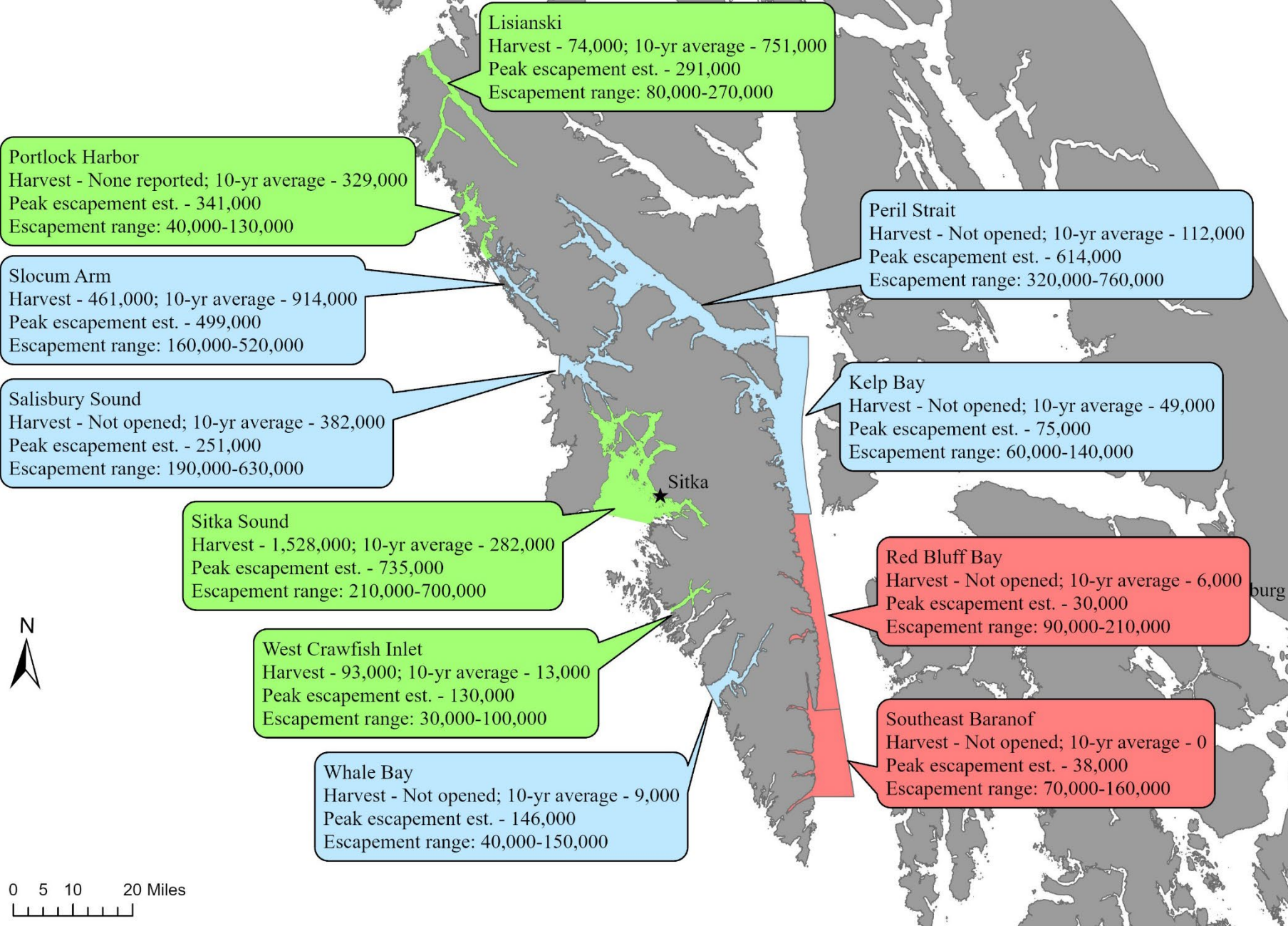

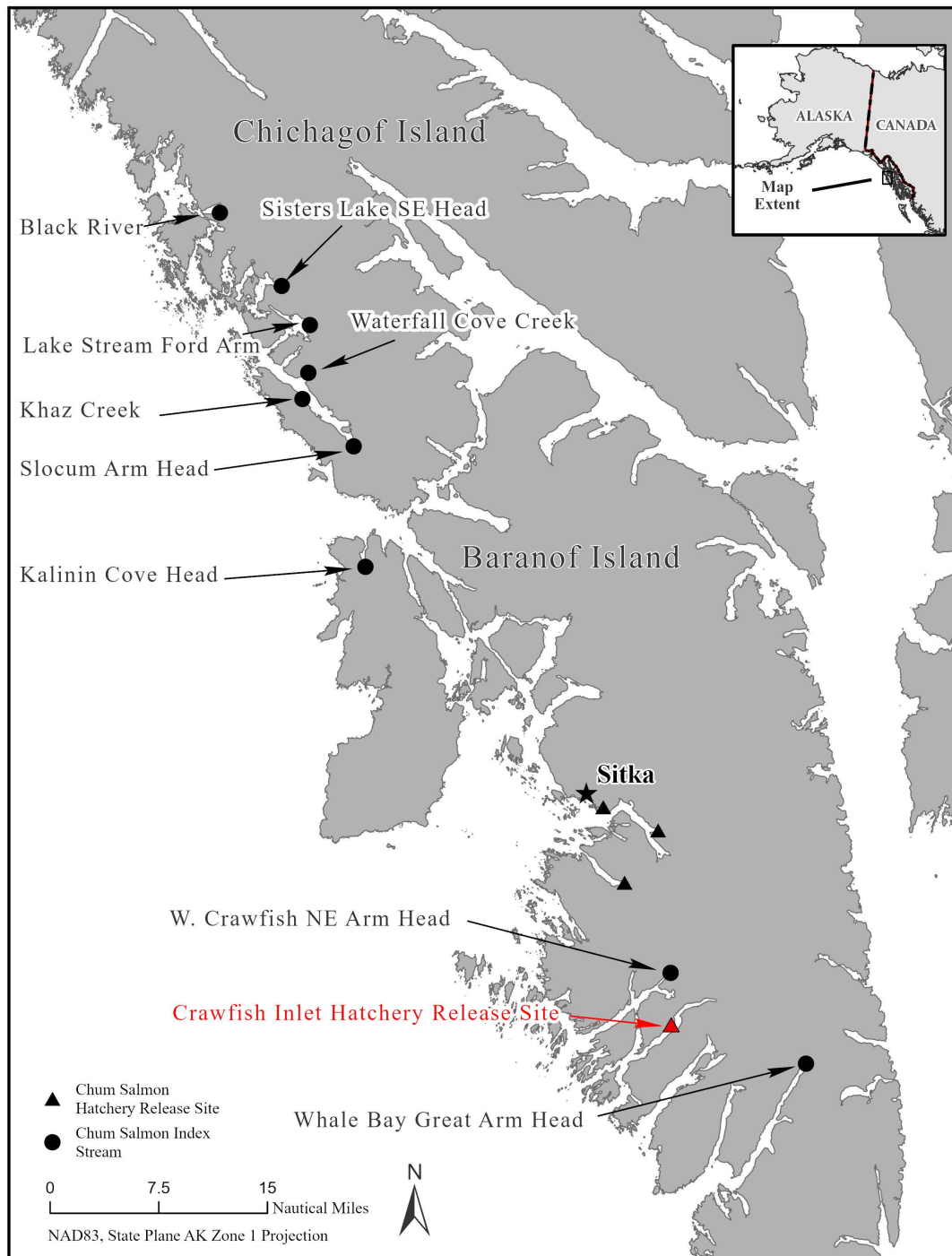


2024 chum salmon overview

- There were no seine openings in the Sitka Management Area to target wild chum salmon in 2024.
- W. Chichagof and Salisbury Sound systems were near average; Whale Bay, W. Crawfish and inside chum runs were poor.
- Peak chum salmon escapements were below management targets for both Northern SE Outside and Inside areas.
