By signing above, I understand that I have registered my permit to fish in the GCI area **only** during 2022 and that I **cannot** transfer to any other area during 2022.

The Alaska Board of Fisheries has authorized the use of monofilament mesh gillnet for set and drift gillnetting in Upper Cook Inlet. You may choose to fish **all** or **part** or **none** of your gear as monofilament. You no longer have to notify ADF&G prior to fishing monofilament mesh gear.

5AAC 21.345. REGISTRATION. (a) Except as provided in (e) of this section, each CFEC setnet permit holder shall register for a registration area described in (b) of this section before fishing, by completing a registration form available from the department and returning it, either in person or by U.S. mail, as set out in (f) of this section, to a department office in Anchorage, Soldotna, or Homer. A CFEC setnet permit holder may not fish in more than one registration area during a registration year.

(b) Registration areas are as follows: (1) **Northern District Area** : as described in 5 AAC 21.200(a); (2) **Upper Subdistrict Area**: as described in 5 AAC 21.200(b)(2); and (3) **Greater Cook Inlet Area**: all waters of the Cook Inlet Area open to setnet fishing as described in 5 AAC 21.200(b)(1), (b)(3) - (b)(6), and (d).

(c) The registration year is January 1 - December 31.

(d) Registration is not transferable between registration areas during a registration year.
