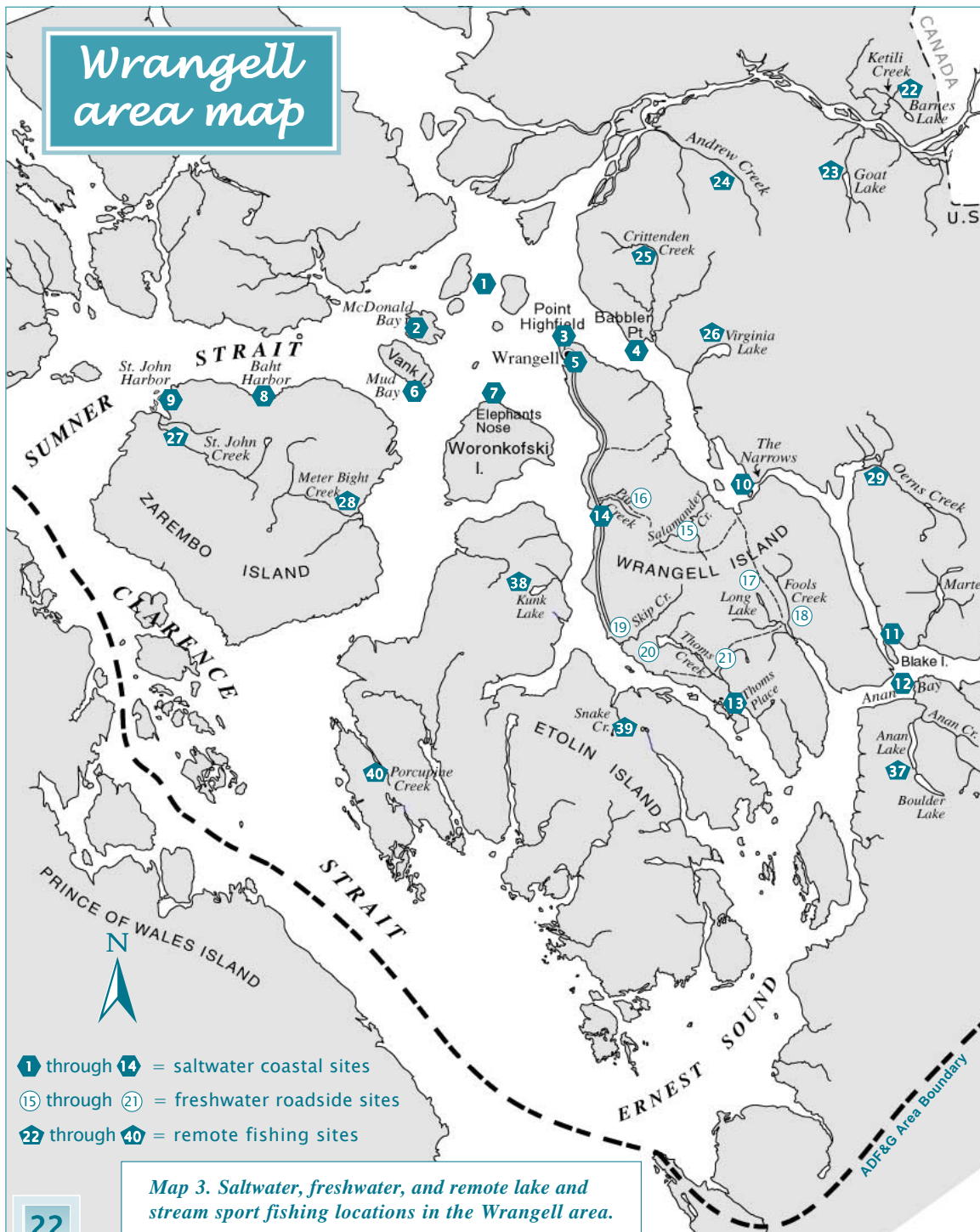

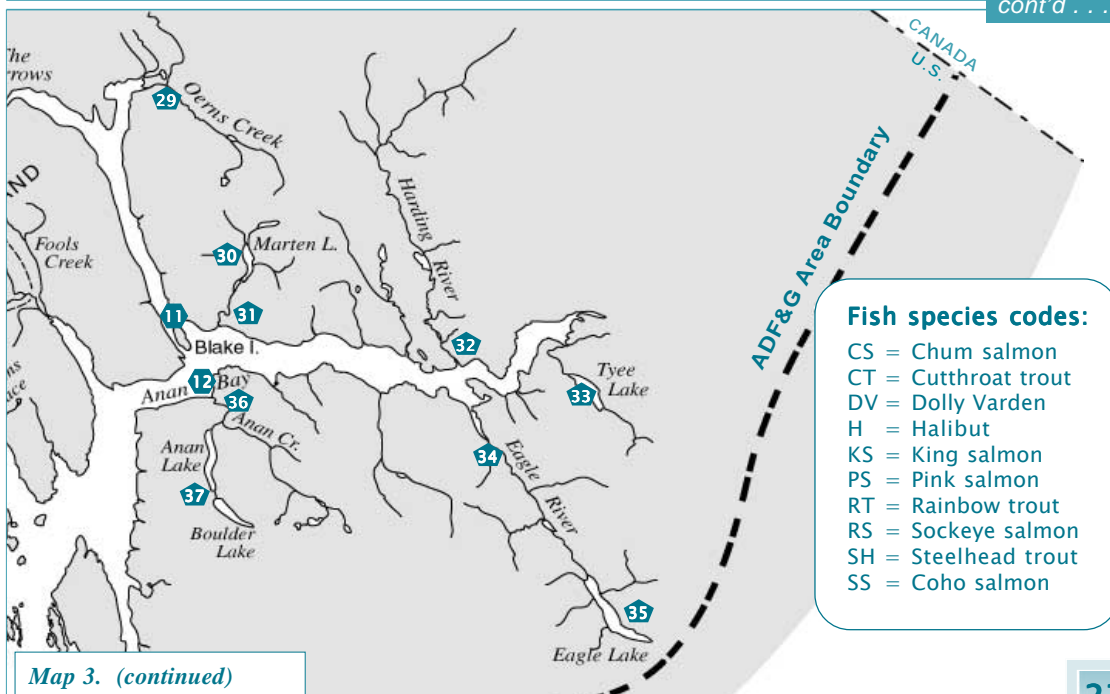
Map 3. Saltwater, freshwater, and remote lake and stream sport fishing locations in the Wrangell area.

Map no.	Area name	Fish species available (code key at bottom of page)	Access/location, facilities
1	Greys Pass	KS(Mar-Apr), H(Mar-Oct)	8 mi NW of Wrangell by boat. Major early king attraction; check regulations for dates and boundaries.
2	McDonald Bay	H(Mar-Oct)	10 mi S of Wrangell off SW Sokolof I.
3	Point Highfield	KS(May-Jun), SS(Aug-Oct), DV(May-Oct)	1 mi N of Wrangell by boat.
4	Babbler Point	KS(May-Jun)	5 mi E of Wrangell by boat.
5	Wrangell Harbor	KS(Nov-Jun), SS(Aug-Oct), DV(May-Oct)	Skiff, float or dock. Winter kings.
6	Mud Bay	H(Mar-Oct)	9 mi W of Wrangell off Vank I.
7	Elephants Nose (the Nose)	KS(May-Jun), SS(Sept-Oct)	5 mi W of Wrangell by boat—major attraction off NW Woronkofski I.
8	Baht Harbor	KS(May-Sept), SS(Aug-Sept)	15 mi W of Wrangell by boat.
9	St. John Harbor	KS(Apr-Jun), SS(Aug-Sep), H(Mar-Oct)	23 mi W of Wrangell by boat.
10	The Narrows/ Earl West Cove	KS(Nov-Jun), SS(Aug-Oct), CS(Aug-Sept)	17 mi SE of Wrangell by boat. Winter kings.
11	Blake I. (Ham I.)	KS(May-Jul), SS(Sep-Nov), H(Mar-Oct)	31 mi SE of Wrangell by boat.
12	Anan Bay	PS(Jul-Sept), SS(Aug-Oct)	34 mi SE of Wrangell by boat. USFS cabin. <i>THE</i> spot for pink salmon.
13	Thoms Place	SH(Apr-May), RS(Jun-Jul), PS(Jul-Aug), SS(Sept-Nov)	29 mi S of Wrangell by boat, 39 mi by car, + 1 mi hike. <i>THE</i> spot for sockeye salmon.

Map no.	Area name	Fish species available (see code key, lower right)	Access/location, facilities
<b>~ ~ Saltwater roadside</b>			
14	Pat Creek Landing	KS(Oct–Jun), DV(May–Sep),CT(Jun–Sep), PS(Jul–Aug), SS(Sep–Oct)	11 mi S of Wrangell by car, 10 mi by boat. Fish from beach or canoe.
15	Salamander Creek	CT(May–Sept), SS(Sept–Oct)	18 mi SE of Wrangell by car. Limited opportunity.
16	Pat Creek/Lake	CT(May–Oct), PS(Jul–Aug), SS(Sept–Oct)	11 mi S of Wrangell by car; 10-acre lake at 125 ft elevation. Major local attraction.
17	Long Lake	CT(May–Sept)	28 mi SE of Wrangell by car + 1-mi hike on surfaced trail. Picnic site with skiff at 57-acre lake (439 ft elevation).
18	Fools Creek	CT(May–Sept), DV/PS (Jul–Aug), SS(Sept–Oct)	32 mi S of Wrangell by car + 1 mi hike. Watch for grizzly/brown bear.
19	Skip Creek	CT(May–Sept), PS(Jul–Aug), SS(Sept–Oct)	21 mi S of Wrangell by car. Limited opportunity. Brown bears in area.
20	Thoms Lake	CT/RT/DV (May–Sept) PS/RS (Jul–Aug), SS(Sept–Oct)	21 mi S of Wrangell by car+1.3-mi hike on trail (20 min. by plane). State Parks recreation cabin with skiff. Grizzly/brown bears in area. 380-acre lake at 220 ft elevation.
21	Thoms Creek	SH(Apr–May), CT(Jun–Aug), RS (Jul–Aug), SS(Sept–Oct)	39 mi S of Wrangell by car. Major local attraction—bears abundant.
<b>~ ~ Freshwater roadside</b>			
22	Ketili Creek/ Barnes Lake	CT(Jun–Sep), RS/PS (Jul–Aug), SS(Aug–Sept)	34 mi NE of Wrangell by boat; knowledge of Stikine R. required. Access limited by tides and river level. USFS cabins along river.
23	Goat Lake	RT(May–Sept)	30 mi NE of Wrangell by plane; 350-acre lake in alpine setting at 1,240 ft elevation. Some trophy rainbows; also goat hunting.
24	Andrew Creek	CT(Jun–Sep), PS (Jul–Aug), SS(Aug–Sep)	18 mi N of Wrangell by boat; knowledge of Stikine R. required. Access limited by tides and river level. Mt. Rynda cabin at mouth of creek on Andrew Slough.
25	Crittenden Creek	CT(May–Sep)	6 mi E of Wrangell by boat. Limited opportunity.
26	Virginia Lake	CT(May–Sep), RS(Jul–Aug)	11 mi E of Wrangell by plane; 8 mi by boat + 0.7-mi hike on trail. USFS cabin w/skiff. Trophy cutthroat in 580-acre lake at 105 ft elev. Combine moose hunting and fishing.
27	St. John Creek	SH(Apr–May), PS (Jul–Aug), SS(Sep–Nov)	23 mi W of Wrangell by boat or plane; 1-mi hike on road from seaplane float to creek. Limited opportunity.

Map no.	Area name	Fish species available (see code key below)	Access/location, facilities
28	Meter Bight Creek	SH(Apr–May), SS(Sep–Nov)	14 mi W. of Wrangell by boat. Limited opportunity.
29	Oerns Creek	SH(Apr–May), CT(May–Sep), DV/PS (Jul–Aug), SS(Sep–Nov)	25 mi SE of Wrangell by boat; access across Aaron Creek tideflats limited by tides. Berg Bay cabin within 5 mi.
30	Marten Lake	CT(Jun–Sep)	36 mi SE of Wrangell by plane; 500–acre lake at 178 ft elevation. USFS cabin with skiff.
31	Marten Creek	SH(Apr–May), PS (Jul–Aug), SS(Sep–Nov)	33 mi SE of Wrangell by boat. Major spring attraction. Anan Bay cabin within 3 mi.
32	Harding River	SH(Apr–May), PS (Jul–Aug), CS(Aug–Sep), SS(Aug–Nov)	43 mi SE of Wrangell by plane or boat. USFS cabin at river mouth. King–size chum salmon, seals, eagles, and brown bear.
33	Tyee Lake	grayling (Jun–Sept)	48 mi SE of Wrangell by plane; 434–acre scenic alpine lake at 1,370 ft elev. Combine goat hunt with fishing.
34	Eagle River	SH(Apr–May), CT(May–Sep), PS (Jul–Aug), CS(Aug–Sep), SS(Aug–Nov)	43 mi SE of Wrangell by boat. Major spring attraction. Brown bear in vicinity.
35	Eagle Lake	CT (Jun–Sep)	53 mi SE of Wrangell by plane. USFS cabin and skiff at 1,060–acre lake at 300 ft elev. Fish in the 20–inch class.
36	Anan Creek	SH(Apr–May), CT(May–Sep), DV/PS (Jul–Aug)	34 mi SE of Wrangell by plane or boat. Anan Bay cabin near creek mouth. Bear observatory and fish pass along trail. Eagles, bear, seals—a major attraction.
37	Anan Lake/ Boulder Lake	SH(Apr–May), RT/CT (Jun–Sep), SS(Aug–Sep)	38 mi SE of Wrangell by plane. Anan Lake: 430 acres at 231 ft elevation; Boulder Lake: 420 acres at 358 ft elev.—an underutilized fishery.
38	Kunk Creek/Lake	SH(Apr–May), CT/DV (May–Sep), RS(Jun–Jul), PS (Jul–Aug), SS(Aug–Sep)	13 mi S of Wrangell by boat +1.3–mi hike on trail to lake; 4.5 mi by canoe/kayak/skiff from Pats Creek Landing. No protected anchorage for larger boats. Limited plane access to 275–acre lake at 275 ft elevation.
39	Snake Creek	SH(Apr–May), PS (Jul–Aug), SS(Sep–Nov)	21 mi S of Wrangell by boat. Late fall coho run.
40	Porcupine Creek	CT(May–Sep), DV/PS (Jul–Aug), SS(Aug–Sep)	28 mi SW of Wrangell by boat. Steamer Bay cabin 3 mi from creek.
