ACTIVITY 1: Identify, evaluate, and prioritize existing and emerging wildlife management issues throughout the region, and identify the planning and public involvement work needed to address the issues

Accomplishments:

- Worked with the USFWS to draft the final section 10j rule and Environmental Assessment to designate wood bison in interior and western Alaska as an NEP
- Began initial planning efforts for the release of wood bison in the Innoko/Lower Yukon region. Those efforts involved
 - o helping the "bison team" create a realistic budget for the release;
 - o helping to write a grant for release of wood bison;
 - o working closely with AWCC to coordinate release efforts.
 - o having teleconferences with Dr Alistair Bath to see whether he would be a good fit for our planning efforts

ACTIVITY 2: Design and implement collaborative planning processes to address priority wildlife management issues and increase stakeholder involvement in wildlife policy decision-making.

Accomplishments:

• Did not design and implement any new planning processes during this reporting period because none were required

ACTIVITY 3: Coordinate collaborative planning efforts with advisory committees and federal and regional subsistence councils, and reports and presentations on planning projects will be made to the State Board of Game and the Federal Subsistence Board.
