

COMMON SLOPE AND PELAGIC ROCKFISH OF SOUTHEAST ALASKA - RETENTION IS ALLOWED All anglers fishing in salt waters of Southeast Alaska will be required to utilize a deepwater release device to return all rockfish that are not harvested to the depth of capture, or to at least 100 feet, whichever is shallower.
