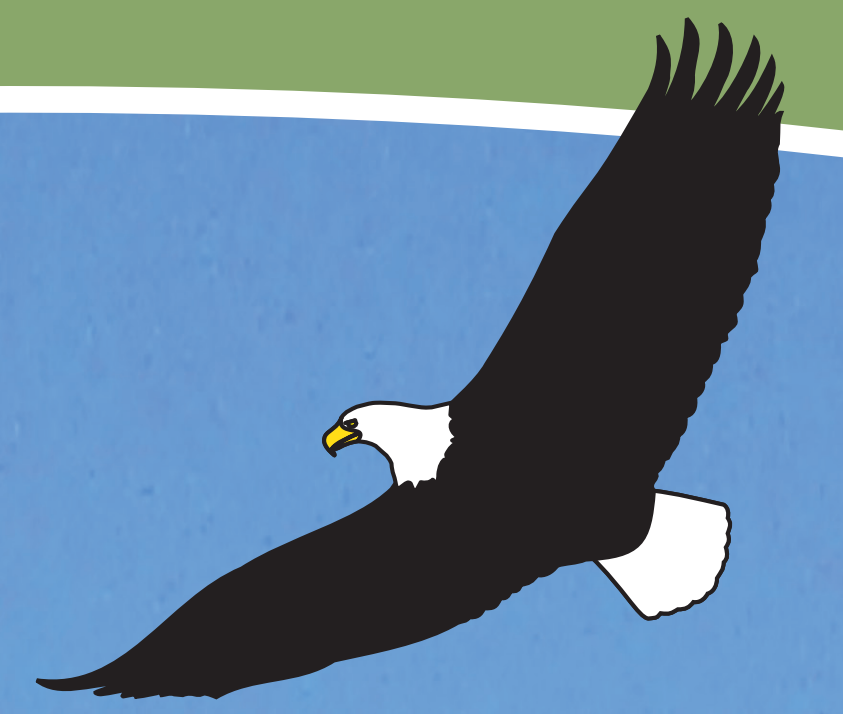

Olnes Pond is home to a variety of fish that you might want on your dinner plate, including burbot, rainbow trout, and whitefish. It is also stocked with Arctic grayling, which you may keep and eat.

Hunting season is exciting for moose and grouse hunters. If you are here to hunt, good luck! Please refrain from discharging firearms within one quarter mile of the campground. Target shooting is strictly prohibited.
