Lower Chatanika State Recreation Area Park Rules

- **Fireworks** and explosives are prohibited.
- * Discharge of firearms or other weapons is prohibited in the campground.
- Campground quiet hours are from 11 PM to 6 AM.
- Fires must be confined to a portable stove or fire ring provided. Wood may be collected from dead and down wood for in park use.
- **Pets** must be on a leash and may not create excessive noise in a developed facility.
- ❖ Use of OFF ROAD VEHICLES (ATV's) is prohibited except for trails officially designated and marked as open to offroad vehicles.
- Operators of snowmobiles and off-road vehicles must be at least 14 years old, or under the direct supervision of a parent or a person at least 21 years of age.
- Speed limit for all vehicles is 10 mph within the campground and on campground roads.
- **Vehicles** are allowed only on established roads and parking areas.
- **Camping** in a designated campground is limited to 15 consecutive days. Vehicles and camping equipment may not return to that area for 15 consecutive days thereafter.
- In a developed area, camping equipment or vehicles left unattended for 48 hours may be impounded, unless authorized by Alaska State Parks.
- Campsites must be occupied the first night and every subsequent night after camping equipment is set up or a vehicle is parked in the campsite.
- *Refuse may not be brought into a park for disposal. Refuse created in the park must be removed or placed in a waste receptacle.
- Disturbing, damaging, defacing, or removing **natural materials** such as plants, rocks, or minerals is prohibited. Gathering berries, fruits and mushrooms for personal consumption is permitted. Mushroom harvest is limited to 10 gallons a season.
- Peddling or displaying of signs is prohibited.
- Permits are required for **assembly** of more than 20 people or for spectator events.
