Important: Guides are required to possess a validated copy of this form or a registration card while guiding hunters. State regulations (5AAC 92.013) require that all individuals providing migratory bird hunting guide services in Alaska must register annually with the Alaska Department of Fish and Game. Guides may register by mail with this form (may take up to 3 weeks), or by walk-in registration at local ADF&G offices. Upon receipt of completed forms, the department will mail laminated registration cards to guides in August along with a renewal letter to all registered guides. To fulfill the annual registration requirement for the next regulatory year, registration forms must be returned annually by June 30th.

Notice: Completion of this form or registration of guides does NOT imply endorsement of any individual guides or businesses by the Department of Fish and Game. Registration does NOT involve any kind of testing, certification, or recommendations concerning the qualifications or performance of any guide. There may be other requirements by state or federal agencies to operate as a guide in Alaska or to conduct guiding operations on certain lands.

ADF&G will post contact information and guiding locations of businesses and principal guides on a public website to help hunters locate migratory bird hunting guide services. Please keep contact information updated and advise ADF&G if you do not wish to have information posted.

Department Representatives: Please complete processing of guide registration forms as follows:

1. Have the guide applicant fill out all blocks of this form. Verify identification.
2. Insert your name, location, signature, and date in the bottom section
3. Make a copy of the completed form for the guide--this is their temporary proof of registration.
4. Mail or fax this form to the Statewide Waterfowl Program as listed on the header.

Waterfowl Program will assign guides a permanent guide number and add them to the database for mail renewals.
