



Catcher-Seller Permit Application

This is an application for a Catcher-Seller Permit. A catcher-seller is defined in 5 AAC 39.130(o)(4) as “a commercial fisherman who sells or attempts to sell unprocessed fish that were legally taken by the catcher-seller

- A) to the general public for use for noncommercial purposes;
- B) for use as bait for commercial or noncommercial purposes;
- C) to restaurants, grocery stores, and established fish markets;
- D) by shipping the fish to a licensed buyer, processor, or exporter within this state;”

Allowable activities are limited to selling fresh, unprocessed resources within the state. Additional activities require additional permits from other state agencies. **Please call (907) 465-6131 if you have any questions.**
