Kuskokwim Subsistence Salmon Panel Guidelines for public comment: January 15, 2015 Public listening session

The panel is seeking comments on potential changes to Kuskokwim River subsistence salmon fishery management. While encouraging all public comment, the panel is seeking to develop specific solutions to address the following aspects of subsistence salmon fisheries management:

- 1. Is there currently an unequitable distribution of harvest opportunities for subsistence salmon along the Kuskokwim River drainage; if so, what options are there to address this?
- 2. What gear modifications will allow subsistence harvest of other salmon, and of non-salmon, during times of low king salmon abundance? USE 8" for Kings, Smaller Kings can go thru 6" for Reds & Chuns.
- 3. What options exist for the development and implementation of community subsistence salmon permits, other subsistence salmon permits, or subsistence salmon harvest records? Being a native allready gave me a permit to fish, none other needed
- 4. What options exist for the development and implementation of a Tier I or Tier II program for king salmon? None not a good Idea
