Bristol Bay Salmon

- 2 Allow schedule change for drift and setnet to help maintain allocation quota more equitably
- 3 Change drift gear from 50 fathoms to 75 fathoms

- 4 Factor in a ratio of setnet/drift permits fishing in the allocation percentage
