We of the village of Levelock would like to support these two proposals that are to create a benefit to the Levelock Packing co, and the Village of Levelock.

The first proposal is 68 which would create a set net fishery in front of the village of Levelock thereby producing a much fresher product for the fish plant closer to the village

This would only be in effect when the Kvichak has reached the minimum escapement goal, the 2013 projected escapement is set at 5.08 million, Harvest goal of 2.36 million.

With these proposals in place they would provide a sustainable community and by creating jobs locally and a market for the fishers from Levelock and the

Surrounding Villages, these proposals would create up to 30 jobs for people who reside in the Community and also provide jobs for people from the surrounding village who wish to be employed for the Levelock Packing Co.

This proposal would be further supported by the previous numbers of the Kvichak report from ADF&G that over the last five years the Kvichak has reached its escapement goals.

Proposal XI would create a regular fishery in the Alagnak river special area when the Kvichak section has openings, this proposal would remove the ASHRA and create another fishing district for fishers who would like to fish the district and provide a product for the Levelock packing co.

There is already a designated fishery boundary in the regulatory books and the Alagnak River harvest goal is .96 of 2.08 million this # for harvest would provide a product that can be caught and processed at the Levelock Packing Co. and provide a market for fishers who wish to fish the district.
