- 5 AAC 06.364 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
- 5 AAC 06.364. Naknek-Kvichak District Commercial Set and Drift Gillnet Sockeye Salmon Fisheries Management and Allocation Plan.
- (f) For the conservation of king salmon, commercial fishing with drift gillnet gear, to the extent practicable, will occur only between the seven-foot flood and seven-foot ebb tide stages as measured at the mouth of the Naknek River.
- 5 AAC 67.022(d)(11) is amended to read:
- 5 AAC 67.022. Special provisions for seasons, bag, possession, and size limits, and methods and means in the Bristol Bay Area.
 - (d) In the Naknek River drainage, the following special provisions apply:
- (11) [IN] the Big Creek drainage, upstream of an ADF&G regulatory marker located <u>at [APPROXIMATELY ONE-HALF MILE UPSTREAM OF]</u> its confluence with the Naknek River, <u>is closed to sport fishing for king salmon year round</u> [(PEON HOLE), KING SALMON MAY NOT BE POSSESSED OR RETAINED; ALL KING SALMON CAUGHT MUST BE IMMEDIATELY RELEASED].
