**Substitute language for Proposal 30** 

5 AAC 06.375(a) is amended to read:

**5 AAC 06.375.** Landing requirements. (a) All salmon must be landed in the district in which **the salmon** [THEY] were taken, except that

- (1) a [. A] vessel used to take salmon may [NOT] have salmon on board when **the vessel is no** more than one mile outside the district from which the salmon were taken;
- (2) a [OR WHEN THE] vessel that is more than one-half mile inside the boundary of the Snake River Section of the Nushagak District may not have salmon on board the vessel, except that a set gillnet fishing vessel may have salmon on board in the entire Snake River Section;
- (3) when outside a district, a vessel used to take salmon may have on board up to 50 salmon for personal use, if the salmon <u>are</u> [HAVE BEEN] headed and gutted:
- (4) the [. THE] commissioner may waive the requirements of this subsection if the commissioner determines it is necessary in order to conduct an orderly fishery [WHEN NECESSARY].
