Re: State Water Atka Mackerel Management Plan

Dear Chairman Karl Johnstone,

FV Taurus received a ADFG Commissioners Permit to conduct a limited experimental purse seine fishery for Atka mackerel in the Aleutian Island state waters this summer to evaluate the feasibility of the fishery. A copy of the Commissioner's Permit is attached.

We have submitted a report on the results of our experimental fishery as RC 22.

Our operations under the Commissioner's Permit took place from August 2nd to August 24th this last summer. As our report indicates, we are convinced that a state water purse seine fishery for Atka mackerel is feasible.

ADFG staff has informed us that the 125 ton allowance for the Commissioner's Permit is the maximum they can authorize as an experimental fishery. There is currently no state management plan in regulations for authorizing a state waters fishery.

The next step is to create a Management Plan for a state water Atka mackerel fishery. Approving a Management Plan is a Board of Fish prerogative.

An ACR must be submitted 45 days before the first fall meeting. Because our experimental research project was still ongoing when the deadline passed it was not possible to submit an ACR proposal for developing a management plan for a state water purse seine fishery for Atka mackerel.

We have discussed working cooperatively with ADFG to develop a draft plan to submit for Board of Fish consideration. We hope to submit a draft plan to the Board in the coming weeks.

In order to have a fishery opening in the 2nd half of 2013, it will require the Board to initiate a proposal on a Management Plan out of cycle.

The framework of a State Water Management Plan should include:

- Area (state waters between 172 longitude to 180 longitude)
- Gear (purse seine, with length and depth limits)
- GHL (a percentage of the federal ABC for the adjacent waters of 541/542)
- Vessel Size Limits (58' LOA)
- Check-in (fishery registration)
- Catch Reporting (daily reports to ADFG)
- Season (July through October)

This is an opportunity to create a new fishery for small boats delivering to shore plants in the Aleutian Island region, bringing employment to struggling communities.
