

5AAC 27.185(s) A permit holder may not retain herring in a closed pound for more than six days and must release the herring by 11:59 p.m. on the sixth day, with the first day being the day that herring are placed into the pound. When releasing herring from a closed pound, a permit holder must lower at least one [FULL] side of a pound's webbing to a position where a portion of the top of the webbing is at least [six] two feet below the surface of the water to allow herring to escape.
