Substitute language for Proposal 78

5 AAC 01.320(b) is amended to read:

- (b) Outside the boundaries of any district, salmon may only be taken by set gillnet, except that salmon may also be taken as follows:
- (2) from August 30 through <u>December 31</u> [SEPTEMBER 30], by spear, dip net, <u>beach seine</u>, and gillnet
 - (A) along a 100 yard length of the west shore of Naknek Lake near the outlet to the Naknek River as marked by ADF&G regulatory markers;
 - (B) [(3) FROM AUGUST 15 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 15, BY SPEAR, DIP NET, AND GILLNET] at Johnny's Lake on the northwestern side of Naknek Lake;

(C) at the outlet of Idavain Creek on the north side of Naknek Lake;

- (3) [(4)] from <u>September 18 through December 31</u> [OCTOBER 1 THROUGH NOVEMBER 15], by spear, dip net, <u>beach seine</u>, and gillnet at the mouth of Brooks River at Naknek Lake; **and**
- (4) [(5)] at locations and times specified in (2) and (3) [(2) (4)] of this subsection,
- (A) $\underline{a \ gillnet}$ [GILLNETS] may not exceed five fathoms in length and may not be anchored or tied to a stake or peg; \underline{and}
- (B) the permit holder must be present at the net while the net is being fished;
 - (5) [(6)] by spear in Lake Clark, excluding its tributaries;
- (6) [(7)] by gillnet and beach seine in Iliamna Lake, Six Mile Lake, and Lake Clark.
