

**REVISED – NEW LISTEN-ONLY SITES
NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING OF THE**

Notice is given that the Alaska Board of Fisheries will hold a teleconference on **Friday, July 24, 2015, at 2:00pm – 4:00pm**. The purpose of the teleconference is to consider a petition for an emergency regulation submitted by the Togiak area fishermen, as signed, requesting the board to amend the registration requirements for the Togiak District under 5 AAC 06.370 to move the registration date from July 27 to August 15.

The board will not take oral public testimony during the teleconference. Listen-only teleconference sites will be provided to the public in Anchorage, Dillingham, Togiak, Twin Hills, and Juneau at the following locations:

The Board will provide additional notice of, and opportunity to comment on, any further regulatory action on this topic, including any action to make an amendment permanent. The Board may also delegate to the Commissioner authority to take regulatory action on this topic.
