5 AAC 75.023 is repealed:

- 5 AAC 75.023. Gear for single-hook waters. Repealed / /2016.
- [(a) IN WATERS DESIGNATED AS SINGLE-HOOK WATERS, SPORT FISHING IS PERMITTED ONLY AS FOLLOWS:
- (1) WITH NOT MORE THAN ONE SINGLE HOOK WITH GAP BETWEEN POINT AND SHANK ONE-HALF INCH OR LESS;
- (2) HOOKS OR LURES (INCLUDING THOSE OF STANDARD MANUFACTURE) MAY NOT HAVE ADDITIONAL WEIGHT ATTACHED TO THEM; WEIGHTS MAY BE USED ONLY AHEAD OF THE HOOK OR LURE.
- (b) MULTIPLE HOOKS ARE PROHIBITED IN WATERS DESIGNATED AS SINGLE-HOOK WATERS.]
- 5 AAC 75.995(a)(1) is amended to read:
- (1) "artificial fly" means a fly that is constructed by common methods known as fly tying, including a dry fly, wet fly, and nymph, or a bare single hook, and that is free of bait [AS DEFINED IN (36) OF THIS SECTION]; materials and chemicals designed and produced primarily to cause flies to float or sink may be used on artificial flies;
