Proposal 85: clarification of RC 146 substitute language.

5 AAC 21.353. Central District Drift Gillnet Fishery Management Plan.

...

(2) at run strengths of 2,300,000 - 4,600,000 sockeye salmon to the Kenai River,

(A) fishing during one regular 12-hour fishing period per week will be restricted to one or more of the following sections and areas:

(i) Expanded Kenai Section of the Upper Subdistrict;

(ii) Expanded Kasilof Section of the Upper Subdistrict;

(iii) Anchor Point Section of the Lower Subdistrict;

(iv) Drift Gillnet Area 1; **notwithstanding the provisions of this subparagraph**

(d)(2)(A)(iv), one regular 12-hour fishing period from July 16 through July 31 may occur in the Central District instead of in Drift Gillnet Area 1;
