Amend 5 AAC 09.360 Southeastern District Mainland Management Plan as follows:

.... repeal and replace b) to read

b) When a harvestable surplus for the first (Black Lake) and second (Chignik Lake) runs of Chignik River system sockeye salmon is expected a commercial salmon fishery in the East Stepovak, Southwest Stepovak, Balboa Bay, and Beaver Bay Sections, and in the Northwest Stepovak Section, excluding Orzinski Bay north of a line from Elephant Point at 55° 41.92′ N. lat., 160° 03.20′ W. long. to Waterfall Point at 55° 43.18 N. lat., 160° 01.13′ W. long. shall open in June for 40 hours and in July for 36 hours beginning at 6 AM concurrent with each opening in 5 AAC 09.365 South Unimak and Shumagin Island June Salmon Management Plan and in 5AAC 09.366 Post-June Salmon Management Plan for the South Alaska Peninsula.

Repeal 5AAC 09.360 (c), (d), (f), (g), (h)
