Amended language for RC 124 regarding 131:

(f) [THE] Eighty percent of the harvest [ESTIMATE] of sockeye salmon [DESTINED FOR THE CHIGNIK RIVER HAS BEEN DETERMINED TO BE] through July 25 in the East Stepovak, Stepovak Flats, Southwest Stepovak, Balboa Bay, and Beaver Bay Sections of the Southeastern District, the South Central District, and the Volcano Bay Section of the Southwestern District, and before July 1 in the Northwest Stepovak Section will be counted towards the 12% allocation in (g) of this section. Beginning July 1, all sockeye salmon taken in the Northwest Stepovak Section are considered to be destined for Orzinski Bay. Beginning July 6 in the East and West Pavlof Bay Sections north of the latitude of Black Point (55°24.48' N. lat.) and the Canoe Bay Section of the South Central District and beginning July 22 in the Mino Creek-Little Coal Bay Section are considered to be pink and chum salmon terminal harvest areas as described in 5 AAC 09.366 (f)(2)-(3) and (g)(3).
