Amended language for RC 124 regarding 131:

(f) [THE] **Eighty percent of the harvest** [ESTIMATE] of sockeye salmon [DESTINED FOR THE CHIGNIK RIVER HAS BEEN DETERMINED TO BE] **through July 25** in the East Stepovak, Stepovak Flats, Southwest Stepovak, Balboa Bay, and Beaver Bay Sections **of the Southeastern District, the South Central District, and the Volcano Bay Section of the Southwestern District**, and before July 1 in the Northwest Stepovak Section **will be counted towards the 12% allocation in (g) of this section**. Beginning July 1, all sockeye salmon taken in the Northwest Stepovak Section are considered to be destined for Orzinski Bay. **Beginning July 6 in the East and West Pavlof Bay Sections north of the latitude of Black Point (55°24.48' N. lat.) and the Canoe Bay Section of the South Central District and beginning July 22 in the Mino Creek-Little Coal Bay Section are considered to be pink and chum salmon terminal harvest areas as described in 5 AAC 09.366 (f)(2)-(3) and (g)(3).**
