I'm Eric Linscheid, a 34 year resident of Kodiak and have fished in almost every fishery here, including over a decade in salmon, both set-netting and seining.

Although there is a divide of people between those supporting and not supporting the proposals before you, isn't it the mission of the Board to conserve salmon, their habitat, and sustain the economic health of Alaska's fishing communities?

Kodiak population is dropping. Adopting Proposals 64-66 alone could result in a 9 million dollar loss in revenue. As the greying of the fleet grows, economic opportunities for the next generation of fisherman must continue in order to sustain economic health of this community.

Making informed decisions based on cause and effect relationships which are supported by data is paramount.

Please consider the credibility of the arguments of the proposals. I could not find any.
