1) Seldovia Salmon Amount Reasonably Necessary for Subsistence. Based on the information provided in RC4 and RC31, the board adopted new regulation 5 AAC 01.566(g) establishing an amount reasonably necessary (ANS) for subsistence uses of salmon in Seldovia. The board selected Option 1 from RC4, 100-350 salmon, as the ANS.
