5 AAC 74.010(c) is amended to read:

(3) in the Chena River and its tributaries, including Chena Slough (Badger Slough),

(A) sport fishing for salmon is closed upstream from an ADF&G regulatory marker located 300 feet downstream from the Chena River flood control structure;

(B) the bag and possession limit for Arctic grayling is one fish, any size from June 1 through March 31 [MAY BE TAKEN BY CATCH-AND-RELEASE FISHING ONLY], except that a person [UNDER]16 years of age or older may not sport fish [RETAIN] for Arctic grayling in the Chena River downstream from an ADF&G regulatory marker located 300 feet downstream from the Chena River flood control structure [DURING A DESIGNATED YOUTH SPORT FISHERY;

(i) THE DESIGNATED YOUTH SPORT FISHERY FOR ARCTIC GRAYLING OCCURS] during the eight designated youth fishing days, which occur on four consecutive Saturdays and Sundays beginning the third Saturday in June;

[(ii) BAG AND POSSESSION LIMIT OF ONE FISH, NO SIZE
