

This is the amended language for Proposition 40
Remove language highlighted and in bold.

(5) in the Kvichak Section of the Naknek-Kvichak District **[from Libbyville Dock to a point near Graveyard Point at 58° 52.07' N. lat., 157° 00.80' W. long. and from the unnamed creek on the northwest shore of Kvichak Bay at 58° 52.25' N. lat., 157° 06.75' W. long. north to a point on the northwest shore of Kvichak Bay at 58° 53.37' N. lat., 157° 04.26' W. long.,]**the maximum distance that a set gillnet may be operated offshore is as follows:

- (A) no part of a set gillnet may be more than 1,000 feet from the 18-foot high tide mark;
- or
- (B) the web of the shoreward end of the set gillnet must go dry at the time of the opening;

If adopted the rule book will read as follows:

(5) in the Kvichak Section of the Naknek-Kvichak District the maximum distance that a set gillnet may be operated offshore is as follows:

- (A) no part of a set gillnet may be more than 1,000 feet from the 18-foot high tide mark;
- or
- (B) the web of the shoreward end of the set gillnet must go dry at the time of the opening;
